### **Meeting Minutes**

## **CALL TO ORDER**

Chair Roger Page called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. on February 5, 2026.

## **ROLL CALL**

## **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

A correction was noted to the January 15, 2026, minutes where a comment attributed to Board Member Boyd was actually made by Board Member Brittany Mason regarding the expansion of Nancy Cummings.

Motion to approve the minutes of January 15, 2026, with the noted correction. Moved by: Vice Chair Welch; Seconded by: Board Member Boyd Vote: Approved unanimously

## **DISCUSSION ITEMS**

### **Fishing Tournament**

The Board discussed organizing a fishing tournament in partnership with Desiree Harbster from Southern States Fishing. Ms. Harbster presented her experience organizing kids' fishing tournaments and education programs, outlining three potential partnership options with varying levels of involvement.

The Board decided to pursue a full partnership where Ms. Harbster would handle all aspects of organization, including education stations, rod and reel distribution, and sponsor recruitment. The city would be responsible for providing a sponsor for food, drinks, and goodie bag items. The Board agreed to hold the event at River Breeze Park on May 9, 2026, and selected "Reel Kids of the Lagoon" as the event name.

Motion to present to the commission a proposal for an all-in fishing tournament on May 9th at River Breeze Park. Moved by: Vice Chair Dru Ann Welch Board Member Janna Taylor; Seconded by: Board Member Janna Taylor Vote: **Approved unanimously**

### **Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Event**

Chair Page reported that seven bicycles had been obtained from the Sheriff's Department for the event. Four additional bikes were donated during the meeting by Tim & Katie Morton. The Board decided to hold the event at Nancy Cummings Park on February 28, 2026, with a noon start time to avoid conflict with morning baseball activities.

The event will include safety education by TPO representatives who will provide helmet fittings and coupons. Board Member Taylor will create flyers to promote the event at the local school.

### **Nancy Cummings Park Comprehensive Improvements**

Board Member Boyd mentioned previous plans for a community center at the park existed in prior Board records. The Board discussed examining these plans and inviting the designer to speak at a future meeting.

### **Rezoning Properties**

Vice Chair Welch presented a comprehensive video detailing the city's recreation requirements based on population. The presentation explained the discrepancy between the comprehensive plan (requiring 6 acres per 1,000 residents) and municipal code (requiring 8 acres per 1,000 residents), and recommended standardizing to 8 acres.

The presentation also detailed inaccuracies in the current comprehensive plan's calculation of recreation space, recommending the exclusion of Canaveral National Seashore acreage and inclusion of other city-owned properties to reach an accurate figure.

### **Monthly Events**

The Board discussed potential collaboration with the Community Trust on future events rather than creating duplicate programming. Board Member Taylor will reach out to the Community Trust to explore partnership opportunities.

There were no citizen comments.

## BOARD COMMENTS & CONCERNS

Board Member Boyd reported on attending STEAM night at the school and discussed with Dr. Hargrave the possibility of involving students in community activities and park improvements. She will send a letter to invite school participation.

Board Member Janna Taylor made a motion to adjourn.

Seconded by Vice Chair Welch.

The meeting was adjourned.
