FUND DESCRIPTION

Laurium Capital has been appointed as the exclusive portfolio manager for our single-managed PPS Stable Growth Fund. Laurium Capital has an absolute return mindset and a longstanding track record in fixed interest, multi-asset high, and alternative offerings. In the PPS Stable Growth Fund (and in our other single-managed strategies) our approach is to identify a manager, through our comprehensive research process, with the skill set and capabilities to successfully manage a strategy, but who does not yet offer such a fund in the retail space.

The PPS Stable Growth Fund aims to achieve moderate returns while preserving capital over the medium to long term. The primary objective of the fund is to outperform the ASISA SA Multi Asset Medium Equity category average. The investment horizon for this fund is greater than five years.







MANAGER COMMENTARY

The PPS Stable Growth Fund A2 ("the Fund"), delivered a strong return of 8.4% for the quarter, with our exposure to both South African equities and fixed income, and foreign equities contributing to returns.

SA equities (39.6% of the fund) performed well, contributing 6.2% to returns, skewed toward the precious metal related names that led the JSE rally, AngloGold Ashanti (4.7% weight, +53.9%), Gold Fields (2.4% weight, +77.2%), Impala Platinum (1.5% weight, +40.0%), Northam Platinum (0.9% weight, +47.9%) and Valterra Platinum (0.6% weight, +56.7%) which the fund added to in the bookbuild when Anglo American disposed of its remaining stake. While some detractors were present, the overall impact of the domestic equity positioning was positive. Domestic Fixed Income (22.1% of the fund) added 1.4% to the fund.

Global equities (16.8% of the fund) added 1.1% to fund performance for the quarter, through the strong underlying fund returns from the Laurium Global Active Equity Fund (utilised within the PPS Stable Growth Fund for offshore equity exposure).

The fund has retained its overweight, relative to its strategic asset allocation position in domestic South African equities and to South African fixed income. Although the fund has narrowed its underweight to offshore equity it remains underweight offshore equities, given our concerns over valuations, and to offshore fixed income.

Over the guarter, we did some tactical SA bond trades reducing some of our overweight duration after the strong performance.

Domestic focused companies have lagged and offer attractive opportunities. An interesting dynamic related to this is the dislocation between our bond yields and domestic equity valuations. SA bond yields have rallied strongly as markets priced in the anticipated 3% inflation target. Domestic focused stocks typically price off the SA government bond yield as the risk-free rate used in the cost of equity but have not followed during the recent SA bond rally. As a result, we think SA focused stocks offer a compelling opportunity at current valuations.

Internationally after strong price gains, headline index valuations are high in historical terms and require ongoing strong earnings and cashflow growth to justify investor optimism The PPS Stable Fund holds shares in high-quality companies that are very well-placed to meet and beat market expectations over time. While periodic volatility should be expected after such a strong period of price gains, the outlook for a number of key segments of the global economy remains highly attractive.

There were no material changes to the composition of the portfolio and underlying managers during the quarter. The fund has adhered to its policy objective.

Transaction requests received after this cut off time will only be processed on the next business day, and will receive the price of that day. Linked Investment Service Providers (LISP), specify their own transaction timelines and may take up to five business days to process. Portfolio valuations occur at 3 p.m. on business days, except the last business day of the month, when it will be 5pm. Prices are published daily and are available in the daily newspapers.

A schedule of fees, charges and maximum commissions are available on request. This fund does not charge performance fees.

The manager may close the portfolio to new investors to ensure the portfolio is managed according to its mandate.
