#### **HELPFUL BACKGROUND**

#### The Passover

The Passover commemorates the night God spared the Israelites from judgment by "passing over" homes marked by the blood of a lamb. It became a central annual celebration of God's deliverance and faithfulness.

### **Memorial Day**

God calls this event a "memorial day" and a "feast," instructing the Israelites to repeat it every year. It wasn't just a ritual, it shaped their identity and reminded them of their shared salvation story.

### **Celebrating Together**

Passover wasn't just for individuals; it was celebrated in homes, in community, with shared responsibility and storytelling, especially to the next generation.

### **KEY OBSERVATION QUESTIONS**

Read Exodus 12

- 1. Why do you think God starts the instructions by resetting their calendar? What does this reveal about the significance of the event? (1-2)
- 2. What specific instructions did God give regarding the lamb, the meal, and the blood on the doorposts? (3-7) What promise did those instructions come with?
- 3. How do the eating instructions reflect the urgency and faith required for what God was about to do? How does it show faith? (8-11)
- 4. What role do children play in this celebration? Why do you think God built this question-and-answer moment into the ceremony? (26-27)
- 5. What does the response of the people show about their faith in God's instructions? (28)

# SPIRITUAL GROWTH

Teaching: What is God teaching you in this passage?

- What does God's command to memorialize Israel's deliverance teach us about celebrating our salvation?
- Why does God have to instruct us to remember and celebrate? What does this teach us about our own nature?
- How does this Passage point to our salvation found in Christ?

Reproof: Have you been convicted of any wrong thinking or behavior?

- How is the idea of structured, intentional celebration different from casual or spontaneous joy?
- What characteristics in God's instructions to celebrate challenged you the most:
  Celebrating regularly, celebrating faith, celebrating together, or celebrating belonging?

Correction: What do you need to correct in light of this passage?

 What prevents you from regularly sharing ways God has worked faithfully in your life?

**Training in Righteousness:** What are practices or habits you can form or change?

- How can you keep passing down the message of God's deliverance to the next generation?
- What special opportunities can you plan to celebrate or remember salvation?
