### HELPFUL BACKGROUND

#### Blood of the Covenant

In the ancient world, blood symbolized life and the seriousness of the oath. Sprinkling blood represented that breaking the covenant deserved death. This points forward to Christ's blood securing the New Covenant (Luke 22:20; Hebrews 9)

#### Mediator (Moses)

Moses stands between God and the people, representing both sides. His mediation foreshadows Jesus, our greater mediator who secures a better covenant (Hebrews 8-9).

#### Covenant Meal in God's Presence (vv. 9-11)

After the covenant is sealed, the leaders see a vision of God and eat and drink in His presence. This symbolizes peace, acceptance, and fellowship—pointing ahead to communion and the marriage supper of the Lamb.

### KEY OBSERVATION QUESTIONS

Read Exodus 24:1-11

1. What's going on in this passage? What's happened before and led to this point?
2. What is Moses leading the people through in this passage?
3. What repeated responses do you notice from the people in verses 3 and 7?
4. In verse 8, what exactly secures the covenant?
5. What is the result of the covenant being sealed in verses 9-11? What stands out about their experience with God?

What right responses did the Israelites have in light of hearing God's covenant code?

Why can't we find assurance in our salvation from what we promise to God?

In what ways have you subtly placed the assurance of your salvation in your resolve, knowledge, or religious activity instead of Christ's finished work?

How does the "blood of the covenant" deepen your understanding of what Jesus accomplished on the cross?

What does this passage teach you about the difference between sincere commitment and true security in Christ?

How does security in your salvation help you become more obedient?
