---

## PRAY FOR ONE ANOTHER

---

Spend some time in prayer for one another.

### HELPFUL BACKGROUND INFO

#### God's Wrath

God's anger here is not impulsive but a holy response to sin. His wrath reflects His love, justice, and commitment to what is good.

#### Mediator (Moses)

Moses stands between God and Israel, interceding on their behalf. He appeals not to Israel's goodness, but to God's character, reputation, and promises.

#### Covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Israel

God had promised to make a great nation from them. Moses appeals to these promises as the basis for mercy, highlighting God's faithfulness.

### KEY OBSERVATION QUESTIONS

Read Exodus 32:7-14

1. What specific sins does God say Israel committed in verses 7–8?
2. How does God describe the people in verse 9, and what does that reveal about their condition?
3. What judgment does God propose in verse 10?
4. What arguments does Moses use when he speaks to God in verses 11–13?
5. What is the outcome in verse 14, and how is it described?

## SPIRITUAL GROWTH

---

### Teaching: What is God teaching your in this passage?

What does this passage reveal about God's character, both His justice and His mercy?

How does this text shape your understanding of how God responds to sin?

What does Moses' intercession teach you about how God provides mercy for His people?

### Reproof: Have you been convicted of any wrong thinking or behavior?

In what ways have you minimized or overlooked the seriousness of sin in your life?

### Correction: What do you need to correct in light of this passage?

What would it look like to stop "self-representing" before God and instead come to Him through Christ?

### Training in Righteousness: What practices can you form or change?

How can you begin to bring your sin honestly before God rather than hiding or managing it?

How can you remind yourself daily that Jesus is your mediator and advocate?
