

## SELECT 200 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### 1. ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS

- 1.1. The Select 200 Terms and Conditions (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement" or "Terms") constitute a legally binding contract executed between **D Globalist Ventures Private Limited** (hereinafter referred to as the "Company" or "DG") and the **business entity or company** that gets selected **to be a part of the Select 200 cohort at DGEMS 2026** (both at the Nomination and Selection Stage) while ensuring fulfilment of all requisite obligations, including payment of Requisite Fee associated with such selection and represented by its founder(s) (hereinafter referred to as the "Select 200 Company", "S200 Company" or "Member").
- 1.2. Whereas, a business entity or company, registering and/or applying to become a part of the Select 200 Cohort for DGEMS 2026 shall be referred to as the "Applicant Company".
- 1.3. Requisite Fee: Both the Nomination Fee of USD 250 (exclusive of taxes and any other applicable fees or charges) and the DGEMS & extrefy Fee (hereinafter referred to as the "Ecosystem Fee") of USD 10,000 (exclusive of taxes and any other applicable fees or charges) are strictly non-refundable under all circumstances including in the event if an Applicant Company withdraws, cancels its participation, fails to participate, or otherwise discontinues its involvement at any stage of the nomination, assessment, or selection process, whether before or after being selected as part of the Select 200, no refund of the Nomination Fee or the Ecosystem Fee, whether individually or collectively, shall be made.
- 1.4. In exceptional cases, where D Globalist grants the facility of "Partial Payments" via tranches to the Member, D Globalist reserves the right to withdraw invitation for selection of the Member in the event of failure of tranche payment within the tranche deadlines communicated to the Member. Further the Member shall not be provided access to any inclusions or elements of the S200 Global Growth Roadmap (hereinafter referred to as the "Roadmap") in case of failure of full payment of Requisite Fee. Partial payments of Requisite Fee made by the Member shall be non-refundable under all circumstances.
- 1.5. At the discretion of D Globalist, sponsored slots would be given to the selected companies from the Select 200. These include top 10 and certain other exceptionally well companies where D Globalist decides to waive off the Nomination Fee and Ecosystem Fee mentioned above.
- 1.6. With the acceptance of these Terms, the Member confirms that it has read, understood and agreed to these Terms.
- 1.7. Where the Member is a company or other legal entity, the individual accepting these Terms represents and warrants that they have full authority to bind that entity.
- 1.8. These Terms constitute a legally binding agreement between D Globalist and the Member.
- 1.9. Unless the context otherwise requires:
  - Words importing the singular shall include the plural and vice versa;
  - References to any statute, law, regulation or provision shall include any amendment, modification, re-enactment or replacement thereof from time to time;
  - References to "including" or "includes" shall be construed without limitation and shall mean "including without limitation".
- 1.10. "Party" shall mean individually either one of the parties to this Agreement, and "Parties" shall mean collectively all the parties to this Agreement, as the context may require.
- 1.11. Any reference to a "Party" shall, unless the context otherwise requires, be construed to include such Party's respective successors, representatives, administrators, employees, affiliates, executors, permitted assigns and transferees, as applicable.

### 2. OVERVIEW

- 2.1 The Roadmap is an exclusive, international growth recognition, networking, and scaling ecosystem designed specifically for the founders of the Select 200 companies looking to expand beyond borders. The Roadmap encompasses a multi-faceted series of offerings, including a flagship annual summit called DGEMS 2026 (organised by Forbes India), extrefy (a digital founder network platform facilitating

cross-border collaboration), peer-to-peer founder synergies, media exposure, brand elevation, introductions, and venture growth support during the defined tenure.

2.2 The brand publications in Forbes India are being managed by the Forbes India team with complete discretion to the content as per their Forbes international guidelines. The Forbes India brand is the exclusive intellectual property of Forbes India and any and all services provided by Forbes India as part of the Roadmap or otherwise, shall be subject to their legal terms of use including Terms and Conditions and Privacy Policy.

2.3. All the Roadmap offerings are ideated and managed by D Globalist.

### 3. SCOPE

- Any fees charged by a third-party service provider i.e., an ecosystem enabler including founders, venture capitalists, and regulatory professionals against the provision of any services, advisory, partnership or any other arrangement between the S200 Company and the third party shall be subject to the discretion of such third party or mutual agreement, as the case maybe and shall not be covered in the scope of these Terms.

## **6. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

### **6.1. Confidentiality & Non-Disclosure**

#### **6.1.1. Definition of Confidential Information**

“Confidential Information” means any information, whether oral, written, electronic, or in any other form, that is disclosed by one party (the “Disclosing Party”) to the other party (the “Receiving Party”) in connection with the Roadmap, extrefy, DGEMS events, or D Globalist ecosystem activities. This includes, without limitation:

- Any information related to the Disclosing Party’s business, corporate structure, expansion plans, operations, financial metrics, valuation, products, services, clients, customers, employees, contractors, affiliates, investors, or strategic partners.
- Any information related to trade secrets, proprietary software, algorithm data, know-how, market strategies, pitch decks, or confidential information of any kind exchanged during formal sessions, market guilds, or informal peer interactions.

#### **6.1.2. Duty of Strict Confidentiality & Restricted Use**

The Receiving Party shall hold in strict confidence and shall not use, publish, broadcast, or disclose any Confidential Information of the Disclosing Party, except to the extent strictly necessary for the performance of its obligations or participation under the Roadmap. The Receiving Party shall protect such information with the same degree of care it uses to protect its own confidential materials, but no less than a reasonable degree of care.

#### **6.1.3. Exceptions to Confidentiality**

The obligations of confidentiality set forth herein shall not apply to any Confidential Information that:

- Is or becomes generally available to the public through no fault, omission, or breach of the Receiving Party;
- Was in the lawful possession of the Receiving Party prior to its disclosure by the Disclosing Party, without breach of any duty of confidentiality or restriction on use;
- Is lawfully obtained by the Receiving Party from an independent third party who has the legal right to disclose such information without breach of any confidentiality obligation; or
- Is required to be disclosed by applicable law, statutory regulation, subpoena, or valid court/governmental order; **provided that** the Receiving Party gives the Disclosing Party prompt written notice of such legal requirement prior to disclosure and fully cooperates with the Disclosing Party’s efforts to seek a protective order or otherwise protect the confidentiality of such information.

#### **6.1.4. Protection of Confidential Information of Other Members**

- The Members acknowledge that while participating in the Roadmap they may have access to confidential, proprietary, commercially sensitive, or non-public information relating to other participating founders, companies, businesses, or ecosystem members (hereinafter referred to as “Other Member Confidential Information”). Members shall treat such Other Member Confidential Information as strictly confidential and shall use such information solely for the purposes of participation in the Roadmap and any related discussions, meetings, or collaborations.
- The Members agree that all sub clauses of Clause 6.1 as far as relevant, shall apply mutatis mundis to the protection, use, disclosure, and treatment of Other Member Confidential Information.
- No Member shall disclose, reproduce, publish, disseminate, exploit, or otherwise make available any Other Member Confidential Information to any third party, except as expressly permitted under Clause 6.1 or with the prior written consent of the relevant Disclosing Party.

## **6.2. Data Protection and Privacy**

6.2.1. Each Party shall comply with applicable data protection and privacy laws in connection with the processing of personal data under the Roadmap. Personal data may be processed for implementing the Roadmap, facilitating introductions, providing extrefy access, organising events, communicating with Members, providing Roadmap benefits and undertaking promotional and ecosystem activities, subject to applicable laws and rules including the Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023.

With the acceptance of these Terms, the Member hereby consents to the use of information by D Globalist provided by them to the Company, or any of their existing or future co- founders for the purposes of giving effect to the various elements of the Roadmap and better provision of any ancillary services to the Member.

6.2.2. The Member shall ensure that it has obtained all necessary permissions and consents required to provide personal information of its founders, employees, representatives or other individuals to D Globalist for such purposes.

## **6.3 Limitation of Liability**

6.3.1. D Globalist's aggregate liability in respect of claims arising out of or in connection with these Terms or any collateral contract, whether in contract or tort (including negligence) or otherwise, shall not exceed the total amount paid by the S200 Company against the Ecosystem Fee to D Globalist as per the clauses of these Terms excluding any and all expenses incurred by D Globalist for the provision of any services to the Member as part of the S200 Global Growth Roadmap.

6.3.2. For breach of any provision for which an express remedy or measure of damages is provided in this Agreement, the liability of the D Globalist, if any, shall be limited to direct, actual damages only and all other damages and remedies are waived. In no circumstance shall D Globalist be liable to the S200 Company for any special, consequential, incidental, indirect or exemplary damages or loss (nor any lost profits, savings or business opportunity) regardless of whether the S200 Company or its representatives were advised of the possibility of the damage or loss asserted.

## **6.4. Indemnification**

The S200 Company agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless D Globalist, from and against any third-party claims, liabilities, losses, damages, penalties, or expenses (including legal fees) arising from: (i) Member or its representatives breach of these Terms; (ii) false or deceptive growth metrics submitted; (iii) infringement of third-party IP rights; or (iv) misconduct during events or overseas meetups.

## **6.5. Force Majeure**

D Globalist shall not be liable for any delay, disruption, postponement, cancellation or failure to perform its obligations due to events beyond its reasonable control including natural disasters, pandemics, war, terrorism, governmental actions, strikes, power or internet failures, venue unavailability, vendor failures or any other force majeure event. In such circumstances, D Globalist shall have no liability whatsoever for any loss, damage, cost or expense incurred by the Member or any third party.

## **6.6. Governing Law & Dispute Resolution**

This "Terms and Conditions" Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall be resolved in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (as amended from time to time). The seat and venue of arbitration shall be New Delhi, India. Proceedings shall be conducted in English and the Parties shall appoint a sole arbitrator to conduct the proceedings, post mutual agreement. A hearing or proceeding can be conducted through video conferencing, audio conferencing or any other virtual/electronic means, in case both Parties expressly agree in writing.

## **6.7. Other terms**

**6.7.1. D Globalist does not guarantee any specific outcome from any introduction, meeting, investment, business opportunity or commercial outcome for any element of the Roadmap.**

6.7.2. Any and all expenses, including boarding and lodging expenses incurred by the S200 Company, or its founders or its representatives for attendance and participation at the Meetups, DGEMS 2026, or any other event organized by D Globalist shall not be covered by D Globalist or its representatives.

6.7.3. D Globalist shall have the right, at its own discretion, to announce a change in the venue, date of event, international participants, agenda, format and any other element of the Roadmap without prior notice due to circumstances beyond its direct control.

6.7.4. In the circumstance of the Select 200 Company's or its founder(s) insolvency, criminal indictment, fraudulent conduct, brand misuse, or material breach of these Terms, D Globalist reserves the right to immediately revoke the Select 200 designation, demand removal of all digital assets, and publish a formal regulatory clarification.

6.7.5. Nothing in these Terms shall create a partnership, joint venture, agency, employment, fiduciary or franchise relationship between D Globalist and the Member.

6.7.6. If any provision of these Terms is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect. In such circumstances, the provision held to be illegal, invalid or unenforceable shall be modified to the extent necessary to render it legal, valid and enforceable.

6.7.7 Owing to limited slots D Globalist reserves a right to reserve attendance to one founder per company in the events organised by D Globalist and forming part of the applicable Roadmap to the batch of DGEMS 2026.

6.7.8. Any notice under these Terms may be provided by email to the official email address of the relevant Party and shall be deemed received upon successful transmission. It shall be the sole responsibility of the User to ensure that their contact information remains accurate, current, and up to date.

6.7.9. These Terms constitute the entire understanding between the Parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous negotiations, representations, warranties, and agreements, whether written or oral.

6.7.10. These Terms shall be binding on and shall insure to the benefit of the Parties hereto and their respective successors.

## **7. Grievance Redressal Mechanism**

7.1 In the event that any grievance, concern, or complaint ("Grievance") arises in connection with the terms, performance, or conduct under this Agreement, the Member shall communicate such Grievance to D Globalist via **[inquire@dglobalist.com](mailto:inquire@dglobalist.com)**.

7.2 D Globalist shall strive to acknowledge receipt of such Grievance within seven ("7") business days and shall take all reasonable steps to resolve the Grievance within thirty ("30") business days from the receipt of the Grievance.
