Congratulations to the 2025 College Dux **Cooper Ogden** on achieving an outstanding ATAR of **97.00**, placing him in the top 3% of the state. Cooper was also the subject Dux of Geography with a Study Score of 45. We also congratulate the Proxime Accessit **Callum Grace** for achieving an ATAR of **96.65**.

We are also delighted to share key highlights from the Class of 2025:

- A strong **17% of students** achieved study scores above 40, demonstrating depth across year levels and promising momentum for 2026 and a testament to the talent and dedication within the senior class.
- Our **highest Study Score of 46 in English**, achieved by **Thomas Henderson**, showcases the strength of our core academic programs and our continued commitment to literacy excellence.
- **Top Study Score Medians Subject Areas:**
 - Applied Computing, Software Development (38)
 - Chemistry (35)
 - Psychology (34)
 - Visual Communication (33)
 - Health and Human Development / History: Revolutions / General Maths / Chinese Language and Culture (32)
- In addition, a number of students were awarded the VCE Baccalaureate 'which is an additional form of recognition for students who successfully meet the demands of studying a higher-level mathematics subject and a language in their VCE program' (VCAA).
