Healing & sealing with diode lasers

Since the early 1980s photothermal Ttissue welding has been postulated as a viable, and potentially superior, alternative to suturing. However, early success was limited by thermal collateral damage to surrounding tissues. With advances in laser technology we have been able to overcome many of these issues. A resurgence of interest in this field has seen an abundance of research into the science behind how lasers interact with tissues and the photochemical as well as the photothermal interactions which are integral in successful laser tissue welding (LTW).
