Recent studies show a significant increase in tooth wear prevalence in all age groups but especially in young individuals. It has thus become increasingly important to diagnose early signs of abnormal wear so that proper preventive, and if needed, interceptive-restorative measures are taken. Tooth Wear has biological, functional and aesthetic consequences which motivates patients to seek treatment, and clinicians must be able to offer conservative options.

This course will teach that treatment involves a comprehensive evaluation, leading to two intervention strategies, namely interceptive or restorative-prosthetic. Prevention is key, and controlling risk factors is a pre-requisite of a successful long term outcome.
