Fleurs de Villes DIANA is a spectacular fresh floral exhibition featuring fifteen breathtaking floral mannequins, created by leading British floral designers and inspired by some of Diana, Princess of Wales' most iconic looks. Behind every floral masterpiece is a remarkable story — from Diana's groundbreaking HIV/AIDS advocacy and humanitarian work to diplomatic tours and her landmark walk through an Angolan minefield. Together, the exhibition celebrates how she used fashion to connect with people, inspire compassion and champion the causes she cared about.
