WHERE TO FIND US


FROM TORONTO: Take the QEW to Hamilton; Exit at QEW Niagara; Cross the Skyway Bridge; Exit at Red Hill Creek Expwy; Exit at Barton Street and turn right; Take first light left onto Woodward; Church is on the right at the first intersection – Woodward and Melvin.

FROM LONDON: Take Highway 401 to the 403; Take 403 to Hamilton, Exit at Lincoln Alexander Pkwy; Take Parkway to last exit from left lane - Red Hill Creek Expwy; Exit Red Hill Creek at Barton; Turn left onto Barton; Take first light left to Woodward; Church is on the right at the first intersection, Woodward and Melvin.

FROM NIAGARA: Take the QEW to Hamilton; Exit at Red Hill Creek; Expressway. Turn right onto Barton. Take first light left to Woodward. The church is on the right at the first intersection, Woodward and Melvin.

BY CITY BUS: From downtown at MacNab Street Terminal, take #2 Barton bus eastbound, along Barton Street to Woodward at Melvin. No transfers required; trip is 30 mins.




DECEMBER

Father Geoffrey Korz

Archpriest Geoffrey Korz is the priest of All Saints of North America Orthodox Church in Hamilton, founding this first English language Orthodox community in the region over twenty years ago. He founded the Orthodox Christian Fellowship at McMaster University, the Orthodox Canada Journal, and

the Desert Wisdom Bookroom.

He served as Dean of Ontario for over a decade, working with community and political leaders on a wide variety of issues related to religious freedom, faith and education, and the sanctity of human life. Working in education for over 20 years, he has written and spoken widely on issues impacting the everyday life of Orthodox Christians.

He was awarded the gold cross, and raised to the rank of archpriest. Father Geoffrey holds degrees in political science, theology, and education, and has worked in public service prior to ordination. He and his wife Matushka Linda are parents to two daughters and one son-in-law.
