Al Pioneer Dr. Guy Tsafnat to Represent Evidentli in US National Initiative for Responsible Al Standards

SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA – August 20, 2025 – Evidentli, a leader in Al-powered healthcare federated evidence generation and healthcare data harmonization announced its selection as a participant in the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) Al Stakeholder Working Group. Dr. Guy Tsafnat, Founder and Chief Scientific Officer of Evidentli, will represent the company in this prestigious initiative aimed at establishing standards for responsible Al governance in healthcare.

The NCQA Working Group, which officially launched on June 25, 2025, brings together more than 30 leading healthcare organizations committed to developing a shared accountability and monitoring model for the safe, ethical, and effective use of AI in healthcare operations and clinical care.

The Working Group's objectives align seamlessly with Evidentli's core capabilities and mission:

Responsible Al governance: Evidentli's technology embodies the principles of transparency, security, and accountability that the Working Group seeks to standardize, with purpose-built healthcare interoperability and governance features.

This initiative builds on NCQA's 35-year legacy of developing trusted healthcare standards, including HEDIS® and Health Plan Accreditation, extending that commitment into the frontier of artificial intelligence.
