

**TUESDAY 7<sup>th</sup> - MONDAY 13<sup>th</sup> APRIL**



Farnborough, Paris, Berlin, Singapore, Avalon to name just a few aerospace exhibitions and airshows held around the world. You now have the opportunity to add a new location and a different continent: FIDAE!

FIDAE (Feria Internacional del Aire y del Espacio) is a biennial international Air Show held in Santiago, Chile. The first show, FIDA'80 was held in 1980. Since 1990 was renamed to its current name.

It is considered the largest and most important aeronautical and space fair in Latin America and the Southern Hemisphere.

The "Chilean Air Force Museum" is officially named the National Aeronautical and Space Museum of Chile and is located in Cerrillos, Santiago. It showcases the history of aviation through its collection of over 90 aircraft, ranging from early designs to modern jet fighters, and includes a separate area for space exploration.

Travel in-country is by local coach operator and driver.

We stay at a comfortable hotel, located in the area of the venue of FIDEA and the National Aeronautical and Space Museum of Chile, on a B&B basis.

Tour price is based on a Land Only basis. You have the option of booking on the same flights as the Tour Manager (TM) or from your local airport to/from Zurich by contacting **Alex** at **H-C Travel** who will book them for you; or booking your own flights to/from the city. ### **PROVISIONAL ITINERARY (all times local)**

#### **DAY 1: TUESDAY, 7 APRIL**

Between 14:10 and 15:10 please check-in/bag drop with Iberia in Terminal 5 at Heathrow Airport. Then meet your Ian Allan Tour Manager and fellow enthusiasts, who will be gathering adjacent to column G on the Departures concourse. Latest check-in/bag drop time is 2 hours before departure is 15:10.

We do not expect our rooms to be ready for occupation, so we drive to the National Aeronautical and Space Museum of Chile which opens its doors at 10:00.
