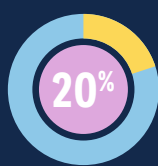

Now is the time to ensure we're **all in the lup** together.

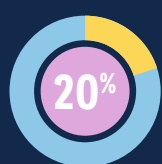
Important facts about LN in Black, Hispanic, Asian, and Native American people

People of color make up approximately **75% of the LN population** in the United States* and are 2-4x more likely than White people to **progress from lupus to LN**.† They also have a higher risk of poor outcomes, such as:

DIAGNOSED YOUNGER AND WITH **MORE SEVERE** DISEASE‡

INCREASED RISK OF KIDNEY FAILURE§

2.5X GREATER RISK OF DEATH THAN WHITE PEOPLE



DESPITE TREATMENT GUIDELINES RECOMMENDING PROMPT USE, **ONLY ABOUT 20% OF BLACK, HISPANIC, AND ASIAN PEOPLE WITH LN** ARE TREATED WITH A BIOLOGIC THERAPY||
