High School Timeline

9th grade

Visit www.bigfuture.org and create a student account to plan for high school & beyond.

Begin turning in community service hours. If working a paid job you may count the work hours for community service.

10th grade

Ensure that all credits have been earned.

In the spring apply for Dual Enrollment (must qualify).

11th grade

Dual enrollment for students with high GPA

& pass the entrance test for FSCJ

Take the PSAT/NMSQT & ASVAB (given at FCCS)

Identify colleges interested in attending & their entrance requirements. [Order class rings.](#)

12th grade

Fall– Apply for colleges and scholarships

SAT (given at FCCS)

Spring– Complete the FAFSA (www.fafsa.org) for financial aid. Bright Future Students must also complete the FFAA (www.floridastudentfinancialaid.org)
