



# SPANISH 1 & 2

## 3 WEEK STUDY PLAN

### Week 1: Foundations & Basic Grammar

#### Day 1: Gender of Nouns & Articles

- Learn masculine & feminine noun rules.
- Practice with definite (el, la, los, las) and indefinite articles (un, una, unos, unas).
- Write 10 sentences using different articles.

#### Day 2: Pluralization & Pronouns

- Study plural noun rules (-s, -es, -ces).
- Learn subject pronouns (yo, tú, él/ella, etc.).
- Practice writing sentences using different pronouns.

#### Day 3: Direct & Indirect Object Pronouns

- Learn how to replace direct objects (lo, la, los, las).
- Understand indirect objects (me, te, le, nos, les).
- Create 5 sentences using direct/indirect object pronouns.

#### Day 4: Numbers & Question Words

- Study cardinal numbers (1-100).
- Learn common question words (qué, cuándo, dónde, cómo, etc.).
- Practice forming and answering basic questions.

#### Day 5: Common Verbs & “Ser” vs. “Estar”

- Learn basic infinitive verbs (-ar, -er, -ir).
- Compare ser vs. estar and memorize key uses.
- Write 10 sentences using ser and estar correctly.

#### Day 6: Review & Flashcards

- Review nouns, pronouns, numbers, question words, and verbs.
- Use flashcards to test vocabulary.
- Try simple translation exercises.

## **Day 7: Listening & Speaking**

- Watch a Spanish video with subtitles.
- Listen to basic Spanish dialogues.
- Practice speaking aloud (record yourself or use language apps).

## **Week 2: Verbs & Sentence Structure**

### **Day 8: Present Tense Regular Verbs**

- Conjugate -ar, -er, -ir verbs in the present tense.
- Write 5 sentences for each verb type.

### **Day 9: Common Irregular Verbs**

- Study irregular verbs like tener, ir, hacer, decir, poder.
- Create a verb conjugation chart.
- Write short sentences using these verbs.

### **Day 10: Gustar & Similar Verbs**

- Learn gustar (me gusta, te gusta).
- Practice other similar verbs (encantar, doler, faltar).
- Write 5 sentences about things you like/dislike.

### **Day 11: Saber vs. Conocer**

- Learn the difference between saber (facts, skills) and conocer (people, places).
- Complete fill-in-the-blank exercises.
- Practice forming real-life examples.

### **Day 12: Reflexive Verbs**

- Study reflexive pronouns (me, te, se, nos, os, se).
- Learn common reflexive verbs (levantarse, ducharse).
- Write a daily routine paragraph using reflexive verbs.

### **Day 13: Review & Practice**

- Go over verb conjugations.
- Take a practice quiz.
- Do Spanish listening exercises.

### **Day 14: Writing & Speaking**

- Write a short paragraph about yourself.
- Try answering questions aloud.
- Have a short conversation (real or with AI).

# **Week 3: Adjectives, Prepositions & Conversations**

## **Day 15: Adjectives & Agreement**

- Learn how adjectives agree in gender & number.
- Study common descriptive adjectives.
- Write 5 sentences describing people/things.

## **Day 16: Possessive & Demonstrative Adjectives**

- Learn mi, tu, su, nuestro for ownership.
- Study este, ese, aquel for locations.
- Write sentences comparing objects.

## **Day 17: Adverbs & Word Order**

- Learn how to use -mente adverbs (rápidamente, generalmente).
- Practice sentence placement.
- Translate English sentences to Spanish.

## **Day 18: Prepositions & Directions**

- Study common prepositions (a, de, en, con, sobre, entre).
- Learn how to give directions (a la derecha, a la izquierda).
- Practice by writing directions to a location.

## **Day 19: Speaking & Listening**

- Listen to Spanish podcasts or videos.
- Answer common conversation prompts.
- Try a simple role-play conversation.

## **Day 20: Full Review**

- Revisit weak areas.
- Take a mock test.
- Do a speaking challenge (describe a picture in Spanish).

- Write a short story or dialogue.
