



DANGEROUS GOODS APPROVAL

Ground Operations Standards

(Dangerous Goods and Special Load Manual – Chapter 2)

Passenger: Members of The Screen Industry Guild of Aotearoa New Zealand
(when requested, membership identification must be produced)

Approved to Carry: **Spare Batteries, Powerbanks**
A total of **60** per person, subject to the following limits:

- only **2 power banks not exceeding 100Wh** per person
- only **2** spare lithium-ion batteries between 100Wh-160Wh or lithium metal batteries not exceeding 2g of lithium content per person
- only **2** non-spillable batteries not exceeding 12V and 100Wh per person

Devices containing a lithium-ion battery exceeding 100Wh but not exceeding 160Wh

Effective: 1st January 2026 to 31st December 2026

This document permits carriage of the above passenger's spare batteries, power banks and/or lithium battery powered device(s) on Air New Zealand aircraft, provided the applicable carriage requirements have been met (see table below).

Note: You **must** see an Air NZ representative to have the items and their carriage requirements checked.

Items, Devices	Carry On	Checked In	Carriage Requirements
Spare batteries	✓	✗	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• all terminals must be protected e.g. retail packaging, taped, speciality container etc.
Power banks	✓	✗	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• no more than 2 per person not exceeding 100Wh• all sockets/terminals must be protected e.g. retail packaging, taped, speciality container etc.• must not be stowed in an overhead locker when onboard
Lithium battery powered devices	✓	✓	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• if checked in:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- must be turned OFF i.e. not in sleep mode- protected from damage and accidentally turning ON
