Bible Study One Sheet

Use this "One Sheet" as your guide to building a productive Bible Study session that will help you be accurate and find new & exciting truths in God's Word. This One Sheet can be used for studying individual phrases, verses, sections, chapters and even full books of the Bible. Enjoy!

STEP 1: DETERMINE THE CONTEXT

Paint the picture of what's happening

Start by reading the previous 10 verses and the following 10 verses from your text and answer these 5 questions:

- 1. Who's the one talking?
- 2. Who's the recipient?
- 3. What are 3 things that have happened to get to this point? (or what's been talked about so far?)
- 4. What's 1 thing that is about to happen next? (or to be talked about next?)
- 5. If you could package the text into a single theme, what would it be?

STEP 2: OBSERVE THE TEXT

Play "I spy" with the biblical text — what do you see?

Read the text several times and then make 10-15 quick observations and write them down:

- 1. Are there any repeated words?
- 2. Are there any unique words?
- 3. What are the verbs?
- 4. What are the nouns?
- 5. What are the adjectives?
- 6. What are the prepositions?

STEP 3: OUTLINE THE TEXT

Break it up step by step — imagine you're guiding someone across stepping stones in a river.

What are the 3 to 5 main stepping stones of the text based on your observations?

STEP 4: INTERPRET THE TEXT

There is only ever ONE interpretation — what does it mean?

You're on the hunt for what the author means in what he says as understood by his original audience.

- 1. Define keywords
- 2. Draw out the meaning of key phrases (exegesis)
- 3. Use Greek grammatical insights

STEP 5: CORRELATE THE TEXT

Support the interpretation with other Scripture, illustrations, and logic

- 1. What other verses talk about the same thing?
- 2. Does the text remind you of a story in your life?
- 3. Does the text describe a clear logic or equation to explain?
- 4. What is the modern counterpart to what is historically being described?

STEP 6: APPLY THE TEXT

Now that's you've drawn out it's meaning, how can it change your life?

NEVER ask this question before you interpret. Interpretation must always come before application.

- 1. Who does this text apply to? (men, women, husbands, wives, fathers, mothers, youth, adults?)
- 2. How is the text intended to be applied?
- 3. Where is the text intended to be applied?
- 4. When is the text intended to be applied?
- 5. What is the best way to apply the text?
- 6. Why should the text be applied?
- 7. What's at stake if the text is not applied?
