

Allen Radner, MD, is the seventh President and Chief Executive Officer of Salinas Valley Health. He is a practicing physician and an expert in infectious diseases.

Dr. Radner earned his medical degree from Rush Medical College in Chicago. He completed an internal medicine internship and residency at the University of California, San Diego, followed by a fellowship in infectious diseases at Harbor-UCLA Medical Center. He is certified in internal medicine and infectious diseases by the American Board of Internal Medicine.

Since 1994, Dr. Radner has held various leadership positions at Salinas Valley Health, Natividad Medical Center, and Community Hospital of the Monterey Peninsula. He joined the executive team at Salinas Valley Memorial Healthcare System as Chief Medical Officer in 2013 and became Chief Executive Officer of Salinas Valley Medical Clinic in 2019.

In November 2023, Dr. Radner was appointed President and Chief Executive Officer of Salinas Valley Health.

In addition to his leadership role at Salinas Valley Health, Dr. Radner serves as Clinical Professor in the Department of Family and Community Medicine at the University of California, San Francisco School of Medicine. He is also the Medical Director of the Natividad Immunodeficiency and Infectious Diseases Clinic and serves as the Tuberculosis Controller for Monterey County.
