BURGUNDY

CHABLIS - AOC

Chablis is a prestigious wine region in northern Burgundy, known for producing crisp, mineral-driven Chardonnay wines with high acidity and vibrant citrus flavors. Its unique terroir, particularly the Kimmeridgian limestone soils, imparts a flinty, steely character to the wines, often unoaked or lightly oaked to preserve purity. Riesling

German Riesling is renowned for its exceptional quality and versatility, showcasing a wide range of styles from dry to sweet. The quality classification of German Riesling is structured primarily into two categories: Qualitätswein and Prädikatswein. Qualitätswein is a quality wine that comes from specific wine regions, while Prädikatswein, or QmP (Qualitätswein mit Prädikat), represents the highest quality tier and includes several levels based on the grape ripeness at harvest. These levels are Kabinett (light and crisp), Spätlese (late harvest, often with more sweetness), Auslese (selected bunches for higher sugar content), Beerenauslese (made from individually selected overripe grapes), and Trockenbeerenauslese (from grapes affected by noble rot, resulting in intensely sweet wines). Additionally, the designation Große Gewächs (GG) refers to the highest quality dry wines from classified vineyards, emphasizing the premium nature of these offerings. This classification system ensures that wine enthusiasts can easily identify the style and sweetness level of the Riesling, making it a favorite among wine lovers worldwide.

These varieties produce prominent red wines that are dry but softer and less tannic than their Nebbiolo counterparts, making them ideal for earlier consumption. Together, they reflect the rich tapestry of Piemonte's winemaking tradition, offering a diverse array of styles and flavors for wine enthusiasts to explore.

Alto Adige, named for the Adige river that runs through the valley, was part of Austria until the end of World War 1, and the inhabitants to this day still follow the customs of their Germanic background, very similar to the populace of Alsace in France. They prefer to call their region Sud-Tyrol, its traditional name. Trentino, further south, has historically belonged to Italy, so names, customs, etc. are Italian. TUSCANY

The most dynamic wine region in Italy. The wine is made throughout the region, but focused in the interior, among the rolling hills and fertile valleys around the cities of Florence and Siena. Today most of the production is focused on quality rather than quantity. Tuscany, home of the famous Chianti, is also home to the so-called “Super-Tuscan”, top quality wines. About 75% of the wines produced in Tuscany are red. This red grape varietal is the native Sangiovese and its various clones: Sangiovese, Brunello, Prugnolo Gentile, Morellino, etc.

Chianti is located in the central hills of Tuscany. Classico is the most famous of the eight zones of the region. Riserva means that the wine has been aged for at least 2 years in wood.

BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO - DOCG

One of Italy’s greatest red wines, Brunello is a clone of Sangiovese from the vineyards around the town of Montalcino, south of Sienna. It makes a rich, dry and powerful full-bodied red wine capable of aging for many years in the best vintages. Beginning with the ’97 vintage, all Brunello is aged for a minimum of 5 years, two years in the barrel. Prior to the ’97 vintage, the wine had to be barrel-aged for at least three and a half years, which many producers felt robbed the wines of some of the fruit character and left the wines overly tannic and rustic in style. A Brunello bearing the label “Riserva” must see at least 6 years of age before release.

MORELLINO DI SCANSANO - DOCG

For centuries northern Toscana held the wine throne. Then along came Sassicaia in Bolgheri and the revolution began. Today southern Tuscan wines no longer have to live in the shadow of Chianti Classico, Montepulciano and Montalcino. While Bolgheri has become the darling of Italian wine fashion nearby Morellino di Scansano DOCG in Maremma is located in the extreme South of Toscana on the border with Lazio. The climate is warmer than in Northern Toscana and produces richer, more powerful wines. Sangiovese does better here than in Bolgheri, but it is also warm enough to ripen cabernet sauvignon.

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SUPER TUSCANS

Super Tuscans are an unofficial category of Tuscan wines, not recognized within the Italian wine classification system. In addition to wines based on the Sangiovese grape, many well known Super Tuscans are based on a “Bordeaux-blend”, meaning a combination of grapes typical for Bordeaux (esp. Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot). These grapes are not originally from the region, but imported and planted later. The climate in Tuscany has proven to be very good for these grapes.
