



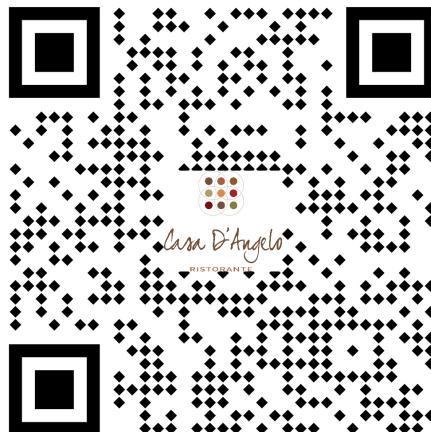

It features Chardonnay, Pinot Nero, and Pinot Bianco grapes, offering fine bubbles and complex flavors of citrus, brioche, and nuts, with styles ranging from non-vintage Brut to Rosé and vintage options.

BARBARESCO - DOCG

Barbaresco is one of Italy’s finest wines, made from the Nebbiolo grape in the village of Barbaresco in the Langhe Hills. Initially dry and tannic, these wines gain complexity with age. They must be aged in wooden barrels for at least two years before release, with Riserva requiring three years. This aging process softens the tannins and acidity, resulting in a well-balanced wine that offers a captivating and evolving tasting experience.

Barolo is Barbaresco's more illustrious neighbor in the Langhe Hills. Barolo is a larger production zone than Barbaresco. This wine is also made from the Nebbiolo grape. It is similar to Barbaresco, but is generally bigger, more tannic and requires longer aging. 3 years, of which 2 are in wood. The Riserva is aged 5 years.

Barbera is one of the most planted varieties in all of Italy, but it truly reaches its greatest potential in the areas of Alba, Asti and Monferrato within the region of Piemonte. In these areas, Barbera is thought of as “the poor man’s Barolo”. When this variety falls in the hands of a great producer, however, it can become one of the world’s finest wines.

BARBERA D’ASTI NIZZA- DOCG

Nizza vines are sun-demanding and normally occupy the best-exposed slopes that face from southeast to west; the valleys are excluded. The production area is the focus of the so-called Tertiary Piedmont Basin, a hilly region that originated from the lifting of the seabed during the late Tertiary epoch; the soils are calcareous, of medium depth, and characterized by sandy-clay marls and stratified sandstones.

LOMBARDY

Lombardy wine country, located in northern Italy, is known for its diverse landscapes and refined wines. It stretches from the alpine foothills near Lake Garda and Lake Como to the Po Valley. The region produces elegant sparkling wines like Franciacorta (Italy’s answer to Champagne), rich reds from Valtellina made with Nebbiolo (locally called Chiavennasca), and crisp whites from Lugana. Lombardy’s varied terroir and climate support both traditional and innovative winemaking, making it a key player in Italian viticulture.

TRENTINO-ALTO ADIGE

Italy’s northernmost wine region is actually two regions that are quite different from one another. Alto Adige, named for the Adige river that runs through the valley, was part of Austria until the end of World War 1, and the inhabitants to this day still follow the customs of their Germanic background, very similar to the populace of Alsace in France. They prefer to call their region Sud-Tyrol, its traditional name. Trentino, further south, has historically belonged to Italy, so names, customs, etc. are Italian. Climatically, Alto Adige is generally cooler than Trentino, although both can get very hot in the summer.

AMARONE DELLA VAPOLICELLA - DOCG

TUSCANY

The most dynamic wine region in Italy. The wine is made throughout the region, but focused in the interior, among the rolling hills and fertile valleys around the cities of Florence and Siena. Today most of the production is focused on quality rather than quantity. Tuscany, home of the famous Chianti, is also home to the so-called "Super-Tuscan", top quality wines. About 75% of the wines produced in Tuscany are red. This red grape varietal is the native Sangiovese and its various clones: Sangiovese, Brunello, Prugnolo Gentile, Morellino, etc.

Chianti is located in the central hills of Tuscany. Classico is the most famous of the eight zones of the region. Riserva means that the wine has been aged for at least 2 years in wood.

BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO - DOCG

One of Italy's greatest red wines, Brunello is a clone of Sangiovese from the vineyards around the town of Montalcino, south of Sienna. It makes a rich, dry and powerful full-bodied red wine capable of aging for many years in the best vintages. Beginning with the '97 vintage, all Brunello is aged for a minimum of 5 years, two years in the barrel. Prior to the '97 vintage, the wine had to be barrel-aged for at least three and a half years, which many producers felt robbed the wines of some of the fruit character and left the wines overly tannic and rustic in style. A Brunello bearing the label "Riserva" must see at least 6 years of age before release.

SUPER TUSCANS

Super Tuscans are an unofficial category of Tuscan wines, not recognized within the Italian wine classification system. While Bolgheri has become the darling of Italian wine fashion nearby Morellino di Scansano DOCG in Maremma is located in the extreme South of Toscana on the border with Lazio. The climate is warmer than in Northern Toscana and produces richer, more powerful wines. Sangiovese does better here than in Bolgheri, but it is also warm enough to ripen cabernet sauvignon.
