## French political developments

Imam Iquioussen deported to Morocco following international legal battle

- After a series of courts' rulings and appeals - some of which deemed the European warrant arrest issued at the request of French authorities as illegal - Belgium handed over Imam Hassan Iquioussen to Moroccan authorities, as per France's wishes.
- The French Supreme Court will release its final ruling on the case in a few weeks.
  A previous ruling - which validated the expulsion order - was based on a legal reasoning which criminalised normative and orthodox religious teachings.

If this reasoning is upheld, the Supreme Court will legitimise a legal breach which could ultimately lead to curtailing Muslims' religious freedom in France even more.

Barcelona Treaty signed, reinforcing France-Spain collaboration and friendship

 France and Spain signed a <u>bilateral</u> <u>treaty</u> to reinforce their "friendship and cooperation."

Article 14 mentions of the treaty mentions that:

 "Each Party reiterates its priority commitment to the fight against terrorism and violent extremism and cooperates in the recognition and care of victims of terrorism."

 The article further proves how counter-terrorism measures and policies have pervaded systems of governance.

Furthermore, it may be a potential foundation upon which France will export its wide and sharp anti-Muslim executive powers to a key European ally.

## Islamophobia

Religious conference cancelled after far-right pressure

- A religious conference organised by two famous imams on the topic of taqwa and ibadah was cancelled by the local mayor in conjunction with the Ministry of the Interior - after both were pressured by the far-right on social media.
- The strategy leading to the silencing of an apolitical expression of religion in France underscores both how entangled far-right narratives and State policies are, and how they have created the space for the far-right to assert themselves.

Deeply Islamophobic content exposed in secularism training delivered to teachers

- A training on secularism given by a Paris-based Institute - to future public teachers was leaked by an investigation website.
- Extracts from the training indicate the stridently Islamophobic nature of the presentation:

"Neutrality in religious matters does not mean equal treatment between religions"

"It appears that certain religions hinder political action to a greater or lesser extent or threaten the social body more than others."

If the objective is the preservation of a traditional way of life and the

maintenance of a certain conception of the relationship between man and woman, Islam, which is a non-traditional religion in France, will have to be opposed more than Catholicism"

 Overt Islamophobic narratives being taught as guidelines for future public teachers will strengthen the legitimacy of State-led policies which securitise and demonise Muslims and Islâm. Furthermore, these narratives will be adopted by students, extending these Islamophobic tropes' influence over time.
