AFRICA'S GREATEST BOW HUNTING DESTINATION

Burchell-Wolf Safaris provides the ultimate African bowhunting experience in the heart of Namibia. We have created the ultimate bowhunting sanctuary, home to unparalleled numbers of quality wild game species. While the most popular method of bowhunting in Namibia is done from ground blinds or tree stands situated strategically over watering holes and well used game trails, clients also have the option to walk and stalk.



BOWHUNTING TREE STANDS

Bowhunting from tree stands is exhilarating and for many the preferred method. At Burchell-Wolf Safaris, we place our tree stands above well used game trails, salt blocks, and watering holes. We encourage our traditional archers to hunt from the tree stand as the shot opportunities tend to be closer, often within 15 yards. If our clients are interested in bowhunting from tree stands, we recommend they bring their own safety harness as it allows for ultimate comfort.



BOWHUNTING GROUND BLINDS

Bow hunting from a ground blind is certainly the most successful method of hunting throughout our winter months. We may set up portable pop-up blinds, but the majority of the hunting will be done from our well constructed ground blinds placed strategically throughout the ranch near watering points. Our ground blinds are spacious with more than enough roof clearance for even the longer recurve bows and can comfortably fit 3 to 4 people. The ground blinds have all been positioned between 20 and 30 yards from the furthest part of the water hole ensuring our hunters have a comfortable shot.



BOWHUNTING WALK AND STALK

The best months to walk and stalk bow hunt are during our rainy season, March through April and again in October. During this time of the year, spot and stalk is ideal as the thick green bush will offer great cover, providing hunters with the chance to get well within range. Spot and stalk can be very difficult during our winter months as the Mopani trees drop their leaves minimizing cover.

NAMIBIA IS HOME TO THE BEST BIRD HUNTING AFRICA HAS TO OFFER

At Burchell-Wolf Safaris, we offer the ultimate add on or premier wing shooting package. Bird hunting is great for the whole family and guarantees you an action packed day. Namibia has a large variety of game bird species that can be hunted from May through November such as three sandgrouse species: Namaqua Sandgrouse, Doublebanded Sandgrouse, and our family named Burchell's Sandgrouse. Also some splendorous dove shooting home to: Laughing Doves and Cape Turtle Doves, in addition to our personal favorite, the Helmeted Guineafowl. Red Billed Francolin, Kurrichane ButtonQuail, and Harlequin Quail are also available. No doubt you will be impressed with the sheer speed and agility our birds acquire as well as the unrivaled number of worthy African game birds our wilderness conservancy is home to.



GUINEA-FOWL, QUAIL, & FRANCOLIN

Burchell-Wolf Safaris home base wilderness conservancy consists of rolling hills covered in thick Mopani and a few open grass plains. This is where our bigger game birds are found, such as Guinea-Fowl and Francolin. The most common method of hunting these birds are driven hunts or flush hunting them with a dog in the open grass plains. While the larger game birds such as Guinea-Fowl and Francolin are resident to the area, Quail are migratory birds and dependent on good rains. Quail are flush hunted, providing our clients with a high speed exhilarating shoot.



NAMIBIAN SANDGROUSE

Burchell-Wolf Safaris is home to all three native Sandgrouse species: Burchell's Sandgrouse, Namaqua Sandgrouse and Double Banded Sandgrouse. These birds can be found in large flocks visiting the watering holes in the early morning and late evening. Taking shots at these agile birds as they approach the water at high speed can be challenging but hunters shouldn't have a problem getting a healthy bag of birds each day. While they are fast, it is their unpredictable flying pattern that makes them one of Africa's most sporty game birds.



DOVES

Namibia is home to a great number of doves. Our wilderness area situated in the Etosha conservancy has a large population of two dove species, the Cape Turtle dove also known as the morning dove and the African Laughing Dove also known as the African ring neck dove. Doves are hunted around watering holes in the early mornings and afternoon, but the best time being from mid afternoon until dusk. It is not uncommon to bag 50 birds per gun in a single days shooting.

ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK

Home to the renowned white elephant, large lion prides, and the magnificent black rhino, Etosha National Park is Namibia's biggest and most iconic national park. Less than an hour drive from Burchell-Wolf Safaris, a visit to Etosha is a great option for a day trip.

SKELETON COAST

Four hours west of Burchell-Wolf Safaris' home base, the Skeleton Coast stretches nearly 500 miles from Namibia's central coast to its northern most border. The Atlantic Ocean's Benguela Current pushes cold air into the arid desert. This phenomenon creates a thick fog that caused ships of days past to run ashore due to shallow reefs and lack of visibility. To this day, many shipwrecks can still be seen on the rugged coast. In addition to the skeletal remains of ships, you can also find colonies of Cape fur seals and sea birds in the area.



NIGHT TIME LION FEEDING

Enjoy the unparalleled experience of a close and personal lion feeding from a permanent ground blind. Every night at the same time, a pride of five or more lions comes to enjoy their evening meal, where you'll be waiting with your camera to capture this unforgettable moment. This is an overnight trip that we offer, during which clients will stay at a five-star lodge tailored for photo safaris. On the same trip, clients can enjoy a drive through a private game reserve with the chance to see some of Africa's most iconic species, such as elephants, lions, hippos, and rhinos.



TOWN TOURS - SWAKOPMUND & WALVIS BAY

Although the Atlantic Ocean which borders the Namibian coastline is very cold, Namibia has some of the world's most beautiful beaches containing white sand as far as the eye can see.
