RAM HOLE CAMP

- BROOKS RANGE -

Our Ram Hole Camp is located in the small village of Bettles nestled at the base of the Central Brooks Range, about 200 miles NW of Fairbanks. This is our Base for all of our Arctic Hunts for Dall Sheep, Grizzly Bear, and Moose. Other animals may be taken on a Trophy Fee basis as well. Great freshwater fishing is usually available and a great addition to any hunt. This is an extremely remote and untouched wilderness that we have been hunting for almost 30 years with great success. All hunts are conducted from comfortable tent based spike camps. Access to the hunting country is either by airplane or jetboat. MMOA conducts almost all the flying and any flying we do is included in the hunt cost.

DAVID RIVER BEAR CAMP

- ALASKA PENINSULA -

Our David River Bear Camp is located on the lower Alaska Peninsula near the native village of Nelson Lagoon, about 480 miles SW of Anchorage. This is our Base for all of our Spring and Fall Brown Bear as well as our trophy Barren Ground Caribou hunts. Mountain Monarchs holds 2 Federal concessions in the Izembek National Wildlife Refuge as well as the adjacent State Land around them. Historically this is one of the best Brown Bear denning areas in the world. Our Caribou hunts are second to none for adventure and trophy quality. Most hunters will hunt from a comfortable tent based spike camp. Some hunting is done right from our Base Camp. Access to the hunting country is either by airplane, jetboat, or 4 wheeler. MMOA does all the flying and is included in the hunt cost.
