1. **HTB Schedule Spring II:** the updated version is on Your Charter and will be shared with you all after the meeting.
2. **Notes from Lucy Ellis:** new items on Your Charter which we're flagging up here to ensure you don't miss them:
  - a) Safeguarding question of the week went up on 23<sup>rd</sup> Feb
  - b) KCSIE 2026: The government is consulting on this until 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2026. A summary from The Safeguarding Network has been uploaded; they're hosting an explanatory webinar on three dates, so you can hear what the changes are directly. The dates are 27<sup>th</sup> February, 9<sup>th</sup> March and 23<sup>rd</sup> March.
  - c) Safeguarding audits are happening soon so please ensure that you look at the adjusted audit pro forma (in HT files section)

Filtering and monitoring checks are really important; KCSIE 2026 proposes to tighten these requirements. Provided everyone is doing these, we are ahead.
