

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# FAQs

## Admissions deadline & process?

## What is the cost?

Tuition and housing for our programs is \$2,950, including 24/7 staff, dorms, meals, 20+ hours of academics, speakers, evening activities, and activity transport. Travel to and from campus is not included.

## Is there financial aid?

## How do I apply? How competitive is it?

## Are students supervised 24/7?

Outset maintains a 8:1 student-to-staff ratio, with ACA-trained staff providing 24/7 supervision. Our programs meet strict safety standards, and campuses are monitored to ensure students are safe at all times.

## What are rooms and housing like?

Outset partners with college residence halls/dorms. Rooms are shared with 1-2 students of the same gender, & shared bathrooms. Single rooms are available (\$300-400).


