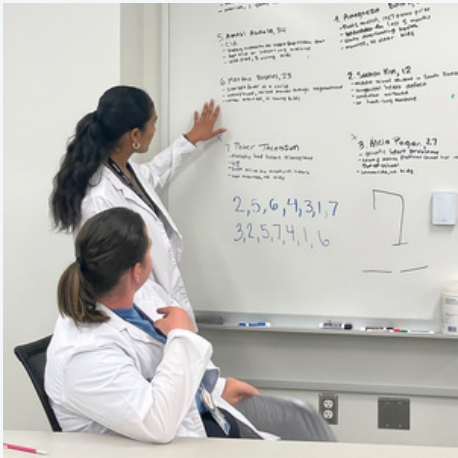

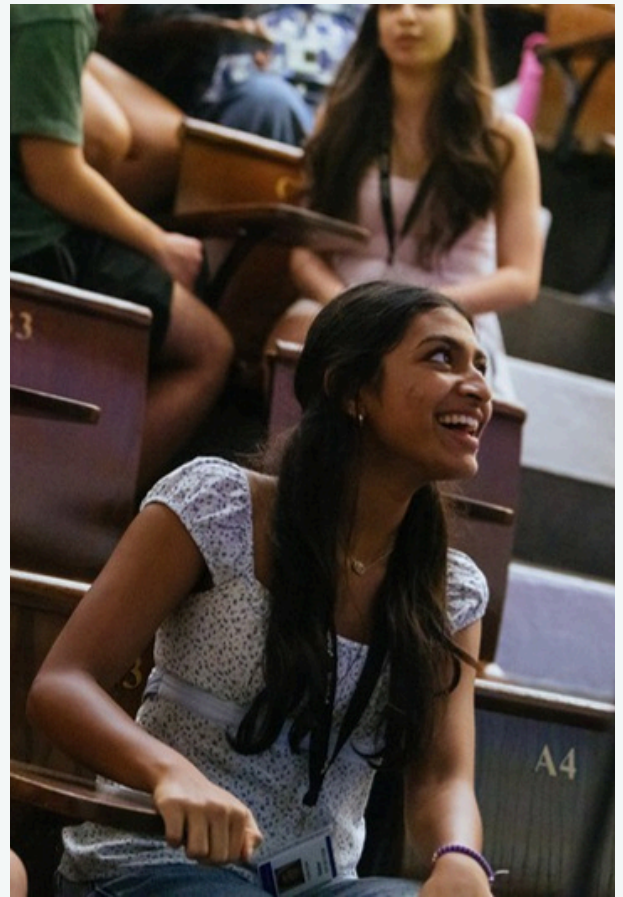

## Dear Outset Alum:

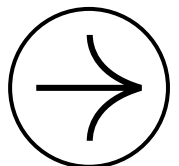
This summer, you did something most students your age never do: you stepped onto a college campus, unpacked your bags, and got serious about your future.

# 5 Ways to Build on Your Experience at Outset



Your Outset program is just the starting point, not the end of your journey. Here are five ways to keep building on your pre-med or pre-health foundation through the school year.

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## **Find healthcare-related volunteer opportunities.**

Contact hospitals, clinics, or charities to find opportunities that genuinely interest you. Even nursing homes are a great option for volunteering! You can gain insight into community health challenges and make a meaningful impact. You may need to be 16+



## **Shadow medical professionals locally.**

Even a few hours shadowing nurses, techs, or doctors across specialties can clarify what you like, and what you don't. Many hospitals or clinics have shadowing programs - often you do have to apply but with persistence you can get in!



## Get hands-on first responder skills.

High school students usually can't be certified EMTs, but you can learn emergency skills through CPR, first aid, or a local junior responder program. This is a great way to get hands on experience and signal you are serious about medicine.



## Join research at a local university or lab.

Find a lab working in a field you're passionate about — biology, neuroscience, public health, and more. Reach out and ask how you can contribute. Many researchers welcome motivated high school students for a project or volunteer role.



## Join your local HOSA chapter.

HOSA (Future Health Professionals) is a national organization that gives students access to workshops, competitions, and leadership opportunities in healthcare. It's also one of the best ways to meet like-minded peers who share your goals.

Every experience you have this year — whether it's a Saturday volunteering at a clinic or an afternoon shadowing a physician — is doing double duty. It's helping you figure out if medicine is really the right path for you, and it's building the foundation of a college application that tells a genuine, compelling story. Admissions committees aren't just looking for grades. They want to see students who have actively explored their interests, taken initiative, and accumulated real-world perspective. The earlier you start, the stronger that story becomes.

It's also worth remembering: this is just the beginning of what the medical path asks of you. Pre-med coursework, clinical hours, research experience, the MCAT, medical school applications — the journey ahead is long and demanding, and that's a good thing. Each step you take now makes the next one more possible. We'd love to hear what you get up to this year. This is way to build your leadership profile, strengthen your college application narrative, and stay meaningfully connected to a community you're already part of.



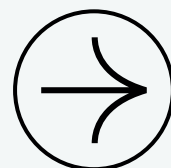

# RETURNING TO OUTSET

## How it works

### Step 1: Core Curriculum

#### YEAR 1 : FOUNDATIONS

"**Foundations**" is the Path-to-Pre-Med or Path to Dentistry/Nursing curriculum you went through during your first week at Outset. This is the entry course designed to give you the big-picture for planning your education and career in medicine.

#### YEAR 2: ACCELERATE

"**Accelerate**" is our year two curriculum. In year two, you'll focus on the courses required for pre-health success. We'll dive deeper into success strategies for courses like organic chemistry or physics. We'll also dive deeper on the MCAT to help you build confidence early.

#### YEAR 3: RESEARCH CAPSTONE

"**Capstone**" is our third year core curriculum and focuses on an introduction to the field of medical research. You will tackle your own research project and also visit labs and learn basic research techniques. Add this capstone to your college application!

### Campus Counselor

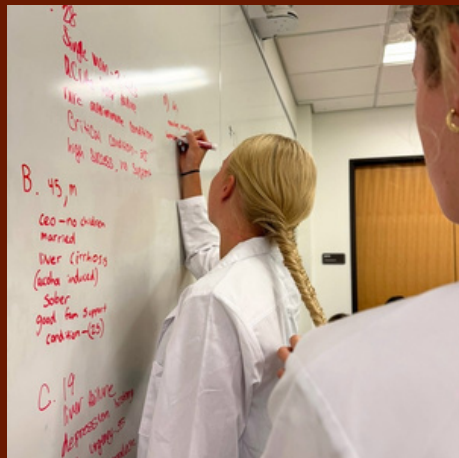
