What to expect in a week at Outset

Hands-On Learning

Students get a firsthand look at what MDs practice, using med-school-level tools and simulation labs with guided supervision. Every program includes its own set of hands-on activities designed to help students understand that specialty.

Examples of activities across programs may include:

Basic Clinical Skills:

Taking vitals, using stethoscopes, and practicing assessments with patient actors.

Simulation Procedures:

Introductory skills such as suturing, administering vaccines, using ultrasound devices, or interpreting medical imaging.

Specialty Techniques:

Track-specific training that may include surgical skills, diagnostic evaluations, emergency scenarios, dental procedures, or other specialty-aligned simulations

Lectures and Q&A with Physicians

Students attend sessions led by physicians from a range of specialties who share firsthand perspectives on medical careers. These interactive discussions help students understand what different fields require and what a day in the life of a doctor looks like.

- What a physician actually does day to day in their specialty
- How physicians choose their specialties
- Training milestones, from college to residency and beyond
- Real stories from the OR and clinic
- Student-driven Q&A about careers, school, challenges, and lifestyle

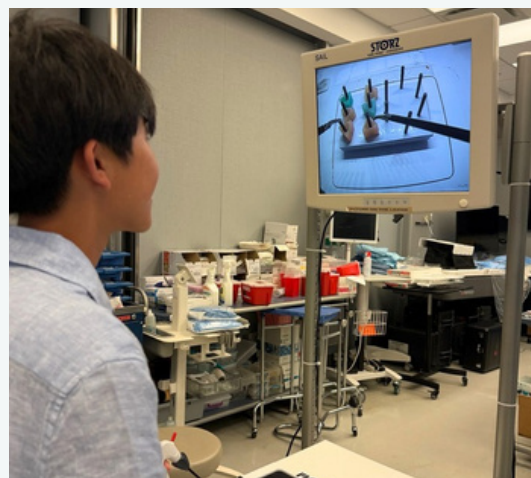
These sessions help students better understand whether a medical career is the right fit for them.

Path to Pre-Med Course

All students participate in Outset's "Path to Pre-Med" curriculum. It is designed by pre-med advisors that demystifies the entire journey to becoming a doctor. Students learn:

- The full timeline from high school to college to medical school
- What pre-med classes to expect
- Strategies for succeeding in challenging courses
- How to choose the right college for their goals
- What the MCAT is, how, and when students prepare for it
- How to make smart choices about extracurriculars, gap years, etc
- What medical school applications look for

A day at Outset

Below is an **example** of what a student's day at Outset might look like. Each summer we tailor activities to each campus, blending labs, workshops, and evening events that bring the program to life.

4:30 – 5:30 PM	Hear from physicians and guest speakers about healthcare in action
6:00 – 7:00 PM	Refuel and connect with new friends over dinner at a local restaurant
7:30 – 9:30 PM	Join our evening activity led by staff: movie nights, bowling, local excursions and more!
9:30 – 11:00 PM	Games, shower, and relax in your campus dorm before lights out at 10:30 or 11:00pm

What is the cost?

Tuition and housing for our programs is \$2,950, including 24/7 staff, dorms, meals, 20+ hours of academics, speakers, evening activities, and activity transport. Travel to and from campus is not included.

Are students supervised 24/7?

Outset maintains a 8:1 student-to-staff ratio, with ACA-trained staff providing 24/7 supervision. Our programs meet strict safety standards, and campuses are monitored to ensure students are safe at all times.

What are rooms and housing like?

Outset partners with college residence halls/dorms. Rooms are shared with 1–2 students of the same gender, & shared bathrooms. Single rooms are available for an additional fee- please check with our team for up-to-date info on cost and availability.

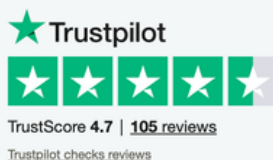
Faculty & Physicians
