How many Children will I be responsible for?

Our staff-to-child ratios will be either 1:8 or 1:12, depending on the age range and product.

Will a uniform be supplied?

What will my working day look like?

On a typical day you will be responsible for:

- Set up or pack down each activity
- · General tidying or cleaning of activity areas

Accommodation is only provided for those working as Pastoral Group Leaders at one of our residential programmes (Johor & Penang ONLY)

What are the hours/days?

Working hours vary across the different programmes: Day Programmes (Monday to Friday) Multi-Activity – shifts are 08:00-16:00 STEAM Focused – shifts are 08:00-16:00 English in Action – shifts are 07:00-17:00 Playtime specific – shifts are 08:00-13:00 CB Lite - shifts are 09:00-15:00 Residential Specific (Weekend work required) We have both day team and overnight positions available. Times vary depending on the role.

What are the rates of pay?

Pay rates are based on hourly and differs for all countries. Rates will be advised during hiring season.

How will I be paid?

Our staff must submit an invoice to our payroll department seven days before the 1st of each month in order to be paid on the 1st. If the invoice is sent later than seven days prior, payment will be released on the 1st of the following month.
