- Support the delivery of high-quality activities following Camp Beaumont's programme plans.
- Help supervise and care for campers during activities, transitions, mealtimes, and rest periods, as agreed with the team.
- Contribute to creating a fun, inclusive, and safe environment where every child feels valued.
- Assist with activity setup and pack down, ensuring all equipment is used safely and correctly.
- Follow Camp Beaumont Asia's safeguarding and health and safety guidance during your time at camp.
- Act as a positive role model, and contribute to a respectful, and professional team culture.
- Provide general support to the camp team to help keep daily operations running smoothly.

Participation in the programme is entirely voluntary. This is not a contract of employment or a contract for services. Volunteers may choose to end their participation at any time, and there is no obligation to perform specific tasks.



VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for a volunteer placement with Camp Beaumont Asia, applicants should ideally:

- Be a resident of the UK and hold a valid UK passport with at least six months' validity remaining from the intended travel date.
- Be aged 18 or over.
- Demonstrate a genuine passion for working with children and young people.
- Be available to volunteer during the international summer holiday period.
- Be fun, enthusiastic, and energetic, with a positive approach to teamwork.
- Have the ability to work both independently and as part of a team.
- Possess fluent English language skills (spoken and written).
- Have previous experience working with children, ideally in an educational, recreational, or activity-based setting.
- For safeguarding purposes, volunteers must provide a valid background check before Camp Beaumont Asia can confirm their placement.

All volunteer placements are offered, managed and delivered solely by Camp Beaumont Asia.

WHAT'S INCLUDED IN YOUR VOLUNTEER EXPERIENCES

This exciting opportunity includes:

- Pre-departure information and guidance provided.
- Guidance with visa & travel logistics. Flight and home country transfer expenses are responsibility of the Volunteer.
- Reimbursement of pre-travel expenses (including visa fees and background checks).
- Travel insurance coverage for the duration of your volunteering placement. *(Note: this does not cover any personal travel outside the contracted period).**
- In-country airport transfers.
- Accommodation and meals are provided to enable participation in the volunteer programme and are not provided as remuneration.
- High-quality training to ensure you're fully confident and ready before camp begins.
- Regular in-country support and communication.
- Official Camp Beaumont Asia uniform.
- A subsistence reimbursement of up to MYR1,000 or THB 7,500 per week, provided by Camp Beaumont Asia to help cover basic in-country living costs. Payment made at the end of Camp in local currency. It is not a wage, salary, or payment for work performed.
- Opportunities to explore South-east Asia's rich culture, beaches, and nature during your free time.

** Volunteers will be covered under Camp Beaumont's Malaysian Travel Insurance for the duration of the camp placement. You will be responsible for arranging your own insurance for any additional personal travel before or after the programme.*



WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED

- Flights and home country transfers.
- Personal travel insurance outside the contracted volunteering period.
- Vaccinations, medical checks, and other pre-travel health expenses.
- Personal spending money for leisure, souvenirs, or independent travel.
- Passport renewal fees or additional visa-related costs (if applicable).
- Accommodation or meals outside official camp dates (including personal travel before or after camp).
