**\*Definition of "Totally and permanently disabled"**

1. Loss of sight of both eyes.
2. Total and permanent loss of speech and mastication function.
3. Damages to functions of the central nervous system, which makes him/her unable to carry out the daily routine activities without others help and support.
4. Damages to the function of thoracic abdominal organs making him/her unable to carry out the daily routine activities without others help and support.
5. Loss of both hands (and its functions) above the wrist.
6. Loss of both feet (and its functions) above the ankle.
7. Loss of one hand (or its function) above wrist or loss of one foot (or its functions) above the ankle.
8. Loss of functions of one hand and loss of one foot above ankle.
