Annual revision date:	1 June
Periodic review date:	the 'annual revision date' in the year 2029
Premium calculation basis:	premiums for your Policy will be calculated on the unit rate basis
Premiums:	£1.1430 per £1,000 lump sum benefit the total premium for each 'policy year' will be payable annually on the 'annual revision date' at the beginning of that year
Catastrophic event limit:	A limit at an employer's normal place of business of £10,000,000 (£5,000,000 in EC or E14 London postcodes) applies except in the following locations: A Catastrophic event limit of £35,792,817 will be applied to the following postcode location(s): EC2N 1HQ If there are any associated policies which are linked for catastrophic event limit purposes these will be detailed in the additional provisions of these Policy Particulars.

Category 001

all eligible employees

Eligible employees:	all permanent employees of the 'employer' (including directors), who are both employed and resident in the UK
Normal inclusion date:	the first 'entry date' on which a person is an 'eligible employee' aged at least 16 but less than 70
Entry date:	day
Cease age:	70 (male) and 70 (female)
Scheme salary:	current basic annual salary or wages only
Scheme benefit:	Lump Sum: an amount equal to 4.00 times 'scheme salary'

Additional Provisions:

Irrespective of anything contained elsewhere, the following provision(s) shall apply to this Policy:

Continued cover for members who leave service in receipt of an incapacity pension

You have not selected continued cover for members who leave service in receipt of an incapacity pension

Continued cover for members who have been made redundant:

You have selected continued cover for members who have been made redundant and this is provided as set out in the Policy Conditions.

Cover ceases no later than the expiry of 6 months after the date that the member is made redundant.

The insured benefit for a member who has been made redundant from the employer's service is the lump sum appropriate to them immediately before the date of redundancy.
