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What is an access report?

- An evaluation of commute options available to a current employee or candidate;
- Analysis of how well connected key recruitment locations are to place of work; including alignment to shift times;
- This includes the cost, convenience and carbon emissions of an employee/candidate's commute and assess whether access to site is or isn't a limiting factor to your recruitment programme.

Why does it matter?

- Restricted transport options lead to a significantly tighter recruitment pool
- This has a knock-on effect to key performance metrics: early leavers, overall staff retention, employee wellbeing, productivity and overall candidate quality.
- Cost of living for employees is significantly impacted by travel to work affecting wellbeing.





Do you save money by riding the service? (per week)





Recommendation

Census data** highlights that there is a high percentage of workers in routine occupations living in Newport, Bridgwater, and Swindon.

To ensure you can attract workers in these areas, we recommend introducing a private service which provides easier access to site from each of these locations.



Analysis

While public transport is available from **Newport**, **Bridgwater**, and **Swindon**, journey time is much longer than travelling by car. Furthermore, all require more than one change mid-journey (from train to bus), with a walk to site at the end of the journey, making travel by car quicker and therefore more attractive. On average, an employee considering travel to work from these locations would be paying between £4200 – £6600 a year to drive to work.

Employees could save between £2300 - £5700 a year with a private transport service, bolstering retention and new recruitment.

Recommendation

While there are trains and bus connections that get employees near to site from these three locations for most shift patterns, they are all **over 1 hour 30 minutes** in duration and travel by car is much quicker, which could deter workers from using this option. In many instances, particularly with transport to site from **Bridgwater**, journey time **exceeds 2 hours**, therefore public transport is not a viable option. There is also no service available for a 6am start and 10 pm finish from all three locations. As there is a lot of competition for similar skills in the area, we recommend both improving access to site for workers living in Newport and Swindon as well as significantly increasing access for people living in Bridgwater.

Our recommendation is to look at the effectiveness of private Zeelo routes from Newport, Bridgwater, and Swindon. This will support if the business has a need to improve candidate quality and reduce dropout rates.
