# What is an access report?

- An evaluation of commute options available to a current employee or candidate;
- Analysis of how well connected key recruitment locations are to place of work; including alignment to shift times;
- This includes the cost, convenience and carbon emissions of an employee/candidate's commute and assess whether access to site is or isn't a limiting factor to your recruitment programme.

#### Why does it matter?


- Restricted transport options lead to a significantly tighter recruitment pool
- This has a knock-on effect to key performance metrics: early leavers, overall staff retention, employee wellbeing, productivity and overall candidate quality.
- Cost of living for employees is significantly impacted by travel to work affecting wellbeing.







#### Recommendation

Census data\*\* highlights that there is a high percentage of workers in routine occupations living in Derby, Burton-on-Trent, and Leicester.

To ensure you can attract workers in these areas, we recommend introducing a private service which provides easier access to site from each of these locations.



#### **Analysis**

While public transport is available from **Derby**, journey time is significantly longer than travelling by car. Furthermore, while public transport is available from **Derby**, **Leicester**, and **Burton-on-Trent**, all, require a 15 minute walk at the end of the journey, making travel by car quicker and therefore more attractive. On average, an employee considering travel to work from these locations would be paying between £2800 – 3600 a year to drive to work.

Employees could save between £1800 - £2500 a year with a private transport service, bolstering retention and new recruitment.

#### Recommendation

While there are trains and bus connections that get employees near to site from these three locations, they are all over 50 minutes in duration and travel by car is much quicker, which could deter workers from using this option. Timetabling also does not align with some shift times. For example, those starting at 6am and travelling from **Derby, Burton-on-Trent**, and **Leicester** via the best most convenient public transport option would encounter a **30-40 minute wait** once they got to site before they could start their shift. As there is a lot of competition for similar skills in the area, we recommend increasing access for people living in both all three locations.

As highlighted above, public transport from all three locations is significantly longer than travelling by car, and in some cases is not available at all. Therefore, our recommendation is to look at the effectiveness of private Zeelo routes from Derby, Burton-on-Trent, and Leicester. This will support if the business has a need to improve candidate quality from further afield and reduce dropout rates.
