



What is an access report?

- An evaluation of commute options available to a current employee or candidate;
- Analysis of how well connected key recruitment locations are to place of work; including alignment to shift times;
- This includes the cost, convenience and carbon emissions of an employee/candidate's commute and assess whether access to site is or isn't a limiting factor to your recruitment programme.

Why does it matter?


- Restricted transport options lead to a significantly tighter recruitment pool
- This has a knock-on effect to key performance metrics: early leavers, overall staff retention, employee wellbeing, productivity and overall candidate quality.
- Cost of living for employees is significantly impacted by travel to work affecting wellbeing.









Census data: Bradford






Recommendation

Census data** highlights that there is a high percentage of workers in routine occupations living in Bradford, Leeds, Wakefield and Castleford.

To ensure you can attract workers in these areas, we recommend introducing private services which provides easier access to site from each of these locations.

See suggested routes for each site on the following slides. We have also included an overview of the public and private transport times and associated costs.





Analysis

While public transport is available to/from central Bradford for all shift times it is much quicker to travel by car. Public transport is also at least double the amount of time from all of the other locations, with all requiring at least one change.

This means that GXO is at risk of not being able to attract and/or retain suitable employees living in these area as the only viable option for accessing the site is via car. On average, an employee considering travel to work to site via car would be paying £1700 – £2500.

Recommendation

While public transport is available from Leeds, Wakefield and Castleford, it isn't available for a 6am start and, in most cases, is upwards of one hour each way. This could deter people who are reliant on public transport from joining, especially if having to start or finish early in the day. We therefore recommend improving access to site for workers living in Leeds, Wakefield and Castleford where there is a high proportion of workers in routine occupations.

By introducing a private transport service, employees would save between £700 and £1500 per year (compared with driving to work or lift sharing) and save a significant amount of travel time (compared with travelling via public transport).

Therefore, our recommendation is to look at the effectiveness of private Zeelo routes for these locations. This will support if the business has a need to improve candidate quality and reduce dropout rates.
