





What is an access report?

- An evaluation of commute options available to a current employee or candidate;
- Analysis of how well connected key recruitment locations are to place of work; including alignment to shift times;
- This includes the cost, convenience and carbon emissions of an employee/candidate's commute and assess whether access to site is or isn't a limiting factor to your recruitment programme.

Why does it matter?


- Restricted transport options lead to a significantly tighter recruitment pool
- This has a knock-on effect to key performance metrics: early leavers, overall staff retention, employee wellbeing, productivity and overall candidate quality.
- Cost of living for employees is significantly impacted by travel to work affecting wellbeing.



Analysis

Employees would have to take a bus and train or two trains and a bus in the case of Goole, to get to work, making travel by car much quicker and therefore more attractive. On average, an employee considering travel to work from these locations would be paying between £3093-£4888 a year to drive to work.

Whilst driving to site is quicker than our proposed routes, employees could save between £1794 – £3588 a year with a private transport service, bolstering retention and new recruitment.


As mentioned previously, employees have to take a bus and train or two trains and a bus in the case of Goole, to get to site. The table above shows no bus services are available for the morning start shift times.

While there are public transport options to get employees to site, they are more time consuming and expensive than a private transport service, with some times not aligning well to shift patterns and resulting in a 47 minute wait for some shifts in Goole. As there is a lot of competition for similar skills in the area, we recommend both improving access to site for workers living in all three locations.







Analysis

Employees would have to take a bus and train or two buses and a train and walk a short distance in the case of Madeley, to get to work, making travel by car much quicker and therefore more attractive. On average, an employee considering travel to work from these locations would be paying between £3083,6-£3354 a year to drive to work.

Whilst driving to site is quicker than our proposed routes, employees could save between £2043,6 – £3707,6 a year with a private transport service, bolstering retention and new recruitment.


As mentioned previously, employees have to take a bus and train or two buses and a train in addition to walking a short distance in the case of Madeley, to get to site. The table above shows no bus services are available for the morning start shift times and most of the night shifts for all three locations.

While there are public transport options to get employees to site, they are more time consuming and expensive than a private transport service, with some times not aligning well to shift patterns and resulting in a 40 minute wait for some shifts in Crewe.. As there is a lot of competition for similar skills in the area, we recommend both improving access to site for workers living in all three locations.







Analysis

There are no public transport options for all three areas to get to site as a result employees would have to take a bus or train to Ellesmere and then a taxi from Ellesmere to Hordley to get to work, making travel by car much quicker and therefore more attractive. On average, an employee considering travel to work from these locations would be paying between £3179,8-£4867,2 a year to drive to work

Whilst driving to site is quicker than our proposed routes, employees could save between £1879,8 - £3567,2 a year with a private transport service, bolstering retention and new recruitment.

Recommendation
