Dear Faith Family,

Let's dive right back into considering the benefits of prayer. Last week, we began looking at **Philippians 4:6-7**. There, Paul wrote, ***"Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus."***

We looked last week at the beautiful truth that our loving Father stands ready to hear our requests. He is a faithful, attentive Father, and we embrace that reality when we pray. Along with this precious benefit, there are countless others. Particularly in these verses, we are told that God's peace ***"will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus."*** The idea of God's peace guarding our hearts and minds is that His peace will watch over us like a soldier on his post.

Think about that for a moment. The very peace of God will continually watch over you and guard you like a soldier when you pray. That is such a profound picture when considered against the anxiety and worry that tries to sneak into our lives. The Lord commands us to pray and when we pray, His peace, God's peace, shows up like a soldier on duty ready to guard our hearts and minds through Jesus Christ.

So, here is another benefit afforded to us when we pray. Let it be a motivator for you and me to pray. When we pray and tell the Lord about those things that try to bring anxiety into our lives, He dispatches His peace to that weakened area, and God's peace shows up like a soldier and pulls guard duty on our hearts and minds. Therefore, you and I need to pray, soldier. When we do, the Lord sends the reinforcement of His peace to guard us. May this be an encouragement to us. May this truth bolster our prayer lives as we pray in obedience and expectancy. Prayer is such a wonderful help on this journey of GROWING IN FAITH!
