



FROM OUR PASTOR'S HEART

Dear Faith Family,

As we continue to deal with the harvest of souls, I want to point out a simple, but undeniable truth. If we are going to see a harvest of lost souls for the kingdom, that harvest will not come without us being faithful to plant seeds of the Gospel in people's lives and water those seeds when we have the opportunity.

The Apostle Paul used this language in writing to the Corinthian Christians. He addressed the factions in that church. The members were divided about their favorite preacher. Paul helped them gain some muchneeded insight into the work that he and Apollos were doing. The apostle explained, 1 Corinthians 3:5–7, "Who then is Paul, and who is Apollos, but ministers through whom you believed, as the Lord gave to each one? I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase. So then neither he who plants is anything, nor he who waters, but God who gives the increase." Paul informed them that in the great work of bringing people to new life, only God could give that increase.

The salvation of souls is something only the Lord God can do. We cannot do that. Our Lord has given us the task of planting seeds of the Gospel and watering those seeds. What does that mean? What does that look like? In a practical sense, every time you have an opportunity to share even a portion of the Gospel with someone, you are sowing a seed in their lives. Following up with that person and continuing to give them Gospel truth is pouring water on that seed.

If you and I will be faithful in sowing seeds of the Gospel and watering those Gospel seeds, we will watch the Lord do the miraculous work of causing that seed to grow in the heart and life of that person. Christ alone does the saving. We do the sowing and watering. I want to encourage you to take every opportunity you can to sow the seeds of the Gospel. If you can share the entire message of the Gospel, by all means take it. If you can only give a person a single verse that points to the saving grace of Christ, by all means give them that verse. Every seed sown is something the Holy Spirit can use to work beneath the soil of that person's heart and bring them to salvation. Let's make it our mission this week to do some Gospel sowing and watering while we trust the Lord for the increase. This is a vital part of GROWING IN FAITH.
