I felt compelled to begin my letters for this year reminding you of the importance of resting in the Lord and waiting on Him.

He will provide for you, and He will protect you as you walk with Him. He will bring about your deliverance and your soul salvation. You have nothing to fear. The Lord of heaven and earth is working in your life. Wait silently for Him! Trusting in Him! Resting in Him is a refreshing aspect of this journey of GROWING IN FAITH!
