Around the Army



January 7, 2026 – Lt. Gen. Christopher LaNeve has been confirmed by the Senate to be the next Army vice chief of staff and receive a fourth star. He will succeed Gen. James J. Mingus, who has been in the role since January 2024. LaNeve is the senior military assistant to the secretary of war, and he previously commanded the Eighth Army in the Republic of Korea.

Gen. Mingus, who is retiring, has held the vice chief position for two years. Before taking this post, Mingus served as the J3, director for operations, and the Director of the Joint Staff in the Pentagon. Prior to that, **Mingus had stints serving as the deputy commander of the 4th Infantry Division at Fort Carson** and commanding the 82nd Airborne Division at Fort Bragg in North Carolina.

4ID History – February Key Events

4 Feb 1945 – The enemy's outer Siegfried Line defense was penetrated with elements of the 8th and 22nd Infantry Regiments at the same place that the 4th Infantry Division penetrated on 14 September 1944. Veterans reported that they occupied many of the same foxholes they had dug in September 1944.

9–11 Feb 1969 – The Medal of Honor was earned (posthumously) by CPL Thomas Bennett, medic with B/1-14 INF, for his actions on 9–11 February 1969. He was the only conscientious objector to earn the Medal of Honor in Vietnam. Bennett Medical Clinic at Fort Hood is named after this 4ID MOH recipient.

15 Feb 1967 – The Medal of Honor was earned (posthumously) by PFC Louis Willett, rifleman with C/1-12 INF.

16 Feb 1967 – The Medal of Honor was earned (posthumously) by PSG E. R. Smith, platoon sergeant with C/2-8 INF.

28 Feb 1945 – 4ID attacked to the east from the Prum river, with 8th and 22nd Infantry attacking at 0515, 12th Infantry was division reserve.
