Instruction for Use

Product Name: OPHTHALMIC INTRAOCULAR SURGICAL BLADES APPA BLADE - (MICRO SURGICAL BLADES)

Intended Use & Indications for use

Ophthalmic Intraocular Surgical Blades (Micro Surgical Blades) are intended to make incision on the cornea, to perform the cataract surgery.

Warnings

- Only qualified professionals are recommended to use and handle the product.
- 2. Select the appropriate type of blade for each surgical purpose.
- 3. Avoid using the blade if the package is damaged or tainted.
- **4.** Do not try to manipulate the product.

Precautions for Use

- Precaution should be taken while handling the blades so as not to damage the cutting edges.
- Use the blade as soon as it is unpacked and dispose it with care as per your institutions procedures to prevent infection.
- Take extreme care in handling. External injury caused by contaminated blade can lead to pathogenic infection linked to blood disorders.
- 4. Do not use if the blade tip is deformed or damaged.

Contraindications

1. Do not use on patient who is too sensitive or allergic to metals.

Prohibitions


- Do not wipe the edge of the blade or use if the blade has been hit against or in contact with parts other than the eyeball.
- 2. Do not use the product beyond shelf life period.
- 3. Do not use for other than ophthalmic surgery.
- Do not reuse or re-sterilize. Reuse or re-sterilize may compromise
 the structural integrity and/or might lead to damage or infection to the
 patient.

Description of the device

This blade is sterilized and has a handle with a grip. The blade is secured in a knife holder. The handle and knife holder are made of polycarbonate and the blade is made of stainless steel.


Operating the device

- Taking out the blade pull the part identified as 1 from the knife holder and raise the blade. Care should be taken as the blade tip 2 may loose its sharpness once it touches an object.
- Put the blade back to the knife holder hold the blade with the blade edge facing downward, push part 3 into the corner of the knife holder and then lightly press part 1 until it slides into the knife holder



Storage & Expiration

- Avoid using the product if any scars and pinholes are seen on the packaging material
- 2. Avoid exposure to direct sunlight, high humidity and high temperature.
- 3. Do not use the product if the expiration date is overdue.
- 4. Discard blades that are kept unused for long time after unpacked.
- 5. Use the blades on a first-in-first-out basis.
- This product may be used up to 3 years after the date of production as indicated on the package label, as long as it is maintained in accordance with the storage procedure.
