III. The Gospel: Beyond One City, One Church, One Man

a) Paul's Planned Journey (Romans 15:23-32)

- Completed phase: Collected aid in Macedonia and Achaia for the church in Jerusalem (the church in need)
- Current goal: Head to Jerusalem to deliver aid, then visit Rome (a pastoral visit)
- Future vision: Reach Spain (the unreached) with the gospel

b) Kindred Spirits in Ministry

- Paul kindled deep connections with companions who shared his passion for Christ and ministry, including:
 - The churches in Macedonia and Achaia: Partners in collecting aid for Jerusalem, the church in need
 - The believers in Rome: Recipients of a pastoral visit, as Paul longed to preach and minister among them

Others

- Barnabas: Encouraged and partnered with Paul
- Silas: Fellow traveler and encourager
- Timothy: Disciple, partner, and son in the faith
- Luke: Beloved physician and companion
- Paul's relationship with these companions was not just a natural connection, but a spark that ignited a deep and meaningful bond, fuelled by their shared passion for Christ and ministry.
- Together, they experienced the joy of reaching out to the lost, spreading the gospel, and building the early church.
