Sermon Title: Advent - Hope in Christ (Contemplative)

30 November 2025

Text: Romans 13:11-14



Scene at the End Time is frightening; it comes quickly and without warning. Suddenly, one person is taken and the other left behind. Which one are you?

Background:

The scripture falls within the segment of the book of Romans on living a testimonial life for mission. Paul gave reasons to do so, which also happen to point to Christ as our ultimate Hope.

1. The time is near:

The end time is nearing day by day; worst still, it could suddenly appear without warning. So are we prepared for it? Jesus had said many parables to warn us, to be prepared for the end time, which ultimately points to us meeting Him again.

- Parable of the Doorkeeper
- Parable of the Ten Virgins
- Parable of the Wedding Feast
- Parable of the Talents

Let us pray as the end is nearing, what have we done, what kind of life are we living to prepare for this end, when we meet Jesus.

Let us pray to stay focused on Jesus, knowing He is our purpose in life, and always seek what He would like to see in our lives.

2. The reason is for Christ:

Christ is the true light and true hope in our lives; knowing Him means we should be in the light and discard the ways of darkness. Although Paul encourages the Romans to live a holy and righteous life for the purpose of doing mission with them. We ought to be living as such with or without a mission, simply because we know Jesus.

3. The strength is from Christ:

The promise of life eternal and a place in His kingdom by a God who is faithful is the greatest motivation we can have. As we have our hope in Jesus, we can also draw strength from His promises to help us discard the way of darkness, which is human nature, and make a conscious effort to live a holy and righteous life.

Pray that as we focus on Jesus for directions, we also draw strength from the promise of this faithful God.
