Sermon Note: Peace in Christ: Encountering God's Promise

Text: Luke 1:5-20 Pastor James Chan

7 December 2025



In Luke 1:5-20, we witness God's peace breaking into ordinary lives under extraordinary circumstances. To have peace in Christ, we must trust God's timing, recognize His active presence in our daily duties, and respond with faith, even when doubt creeps in.

1. Trust God's timing (vv. 5-7)

Zechariah and Elizabeth lived righteously, yet they faced barrenness and old age. Like them, we may experience seasons of waiting where God's promises seem delayed. Yet, persistent obedience and prayer reflect faith (Philippians 4:6-7). So trust God's timing in "dead ends" (e.g., stalled cell groups and ministries, corporate or individual revival). Just as God fulfilled His promise to Zechariah and Elizabeth, He brings hope and peace in our waiting times.

2. Expect God in routines (vv. 8-17)

Zechariah's routine priestly service was interrupted by the angel Gabriel, announcing God's plan for John's birth. This reminds us that God uses our everyday tasks and ministries as platforms for His mission. We are called to be alert to God's presence and ready for divine interruptions that advance His kingdom. So expect God in routines, e.g, Bible study, outreach, and fellowship meetings. Serve like John, as forerunner to the Messiah's peace (Isa 9:6).

3. Respond with faith (vv. 18-20)

Zechariah's doubt cost him his voice until God's promise was fulfilled. Our peace in Christ grows when we trust God's word above our uncertainties. Like Mary's faithful response (Luke 1:38), embracing God's promises brings peace that surpasses understanding (John 16:33).

Let us reflect on our own lives and ministries, asking God to help us wait faithfully, serve expectantly, and believe boldly so that His peace may reign in us and through us.

Text: Luke 1:5-20

- 1. How do you relate to Zechariah and Elizabeth's experience of waiting on God's promise?
- 2. What areas in your life or ministry feel "barren" or delayed right now? How can you practice patience and trust God's timing (Philippians 4:6-7) in these seasons?
- 3. Have you ever experienced God interrupting your routine or daily tasks in a way that changed your perspective or mission?
- 4. How can we be more attentive to God's presence and calling in our ordinary ministries or cell group meetings?
- 5. What doubts or fears keep you from fully trusting God's promises as Zechariah struggled?
- 6. What is one practical step you can take this week to surrender a "barren" area of your life or ministry to God's peace?
