As a Christian, by what authority are we empowered, and what are we empowered to do?

Background:

Structure of the Book of Isaiah

- Ch. 1–39 Proto-Isaiah: Isaiah's ministry in Jerusalem and prophecy.
- Ch. 40–55 Deutero-Isaiah: Addressed to the exilic community in Babylon, focusing on God's redemption through the Suffering Servant.
- Ch. 56–66 Trito-Isaiah: Addressed to the remnant returning to Jerusalem, focusing on the hope of a new creation and proper worship in the restored city.

Chosen to be empowered

The suffering servant in Deutero-Isaiah refers to Jesus Christ himself. As we are called to be imitators of Christ, to be little Christs, let us take example from Jesus. As the suffering servant or Christ is chosen and empowered by God the Father, so are we chosen and empowered by the Trinitarian Godhead.

Are you certain that you are empowered by God?

References: Isaiah 42:1 / Acts 8:26-39 / 1 Cor 11:1 / John 15:16

1. Empowered to be humble

As the suffering servant stays humble and does not lift his voice, remains gentle and does not break a bruised reed, nor quench a faint wick. Christ also stays humble and relies only on His ministry; He remains gentle and does not judge and punish while upholding justice. As the suffering servant will not go faint and be discouraged, so did Christ persevere on despite traps and opposition from Pharisees and scribes.

Can you stay humble and gentle despite adversities, yet not forgetting justice?

References: Isaiah 42:2-4, 6a / John 2:23, 8:1-11 / Matthew 22:15-22 / Mark 3:1-6

2. Empowered to uphold justice

The suffering servant stays humble, gentle, and perseveres to faithfully bring forth justice. This is so because the Lord has called Him in righteousness. He will not grow faint or be discouraged till he has established justice. So did Christ as he faced trickery from the Pharisees and adversities for kings and those in power.

Are we going to stand for justice in challenging times?

References: Isaiah 42:2-4, 6a / Luke 13:32-35

3. Empowered for deliverance

To open the eyes of the blind and bring out the prisoners means to help the lost world see the gospel, and with that be set free from the bondage of sin. Christ did just that in the healing of the blind man in John chapter 9. Not only did the blind man see the world, but he could also see the truth that Jesus is from God, and the incompetence of the Pharisees. The truth has set the blind man free to follow Jesus in verse 38.

Are you committed to sharing the Gospel with many?

References: Isaiah 42:6b, 7 / John 9:1-41.

Summary:

You are empowered by the trinitarian God to stay humble and remain gentle in times of challenges, persevere to uphold justice, and bring forth the Gospel to deliver those who are in darkness and bondage of sin.
