Title : Created To Proclaim

Pastor Geraldine Lau

Text : Jeremiah 1:4-10

18 January 2026

Theme: God calls, equips, and empowers His people to proclaim His Word.

Jeremiah's call illustrates God's intimate relationship with His chosen, empowering them to fulfil their divine mission despite personal inadequacies.

I. The Call of Jeremiah (4-5)

Jeremiah receives a divine call from God, emphasizing that he was known and consecrated even before birth. God appoints him as a prophet to the nations, highlighting the significance of his mission.

II. Human Hesitation and Divine Assurance (6-8)

Jeremiah expresses his fear and inadequacy due to his youth, but God reassures him not to be afraid, promising His presence and guidance.

III. Divine Empowerment and Responsibility (9-10)

God empowers Jeremiah by placing His words in his mouth, entrusting him with the responsibility to communicate His messages of judgment and restoration to the people of Judah.

Relevance to Believers Today

The call of Jeremiah serves as a reminder that all believers are chosen and commissioned to share God's message, relying on His strength and compassion.

Discussion/Reflection Questions

1. How does knowing God chose you before birth (Jer 1:5) shape your understanding of His purpose for your life?
2. What excuses or fears do you struggle with when God calls you to serve (Jer 1:6)?
3. How does God's promise of presence (Jer 1:8) change the way you approach challenges in ministry or daily life?
