Join us for **40 Days in the Word**, a powerful six-week journey designed to move us from biblical information to genuine life transformation. Using Pastor Rick Warren's practical, time-tested methods, you'll learn how to pronounce, picture, and pray Scripture until it becomes part of your everyday life. Don't settle for simply hearing God's Word—learn to live it and rediscover a deeper passion for God's truth together as a church family.

The study introduces six specific methods of meditation designed to unlock the meaning of Scripture. These methods are practiced together in small groups and then applied individually throughout the week.

Session	Method	Description
One	Pronounce It!	Reading a verse aloud multiple times, emphasizing a different word each time to reveal new layers of meaning.
Two	Picture It!	Visualizing the scene or the truth of the passage to better understand the context and emotional weight.
Three	Probe It!	Asking targeted questions of the text (who, what, where, when, why) to dig deeper into its message.
Four	Paraphrase It!	Rewriting the passage in your own words to ensure a clear personal grasp of the concept.
Five	Personalize It! / Pray It!	Replacing biblical pronouns with your own name and turning the text into a personal prayer back to God.
Six	Principles of Interpretation	Learning the foundational rules for correctly understanding and applying biblical truths.

Epiphany 4

Sermon Title : A Foundation to Build On

Pastor James Chan

Text : 1 Corinthians 3:10-17

1 February 2026

Introduction

Paul speaks to a divided Corinthian church with a loving but urgent reminder: Jesus Christ is the only foundation he laid (vv. 10–11). What we build on that foundation matters, because our work will be tested by fire for what lasts eternally (vv. 12–15). And most striking of all, together we are God's holy temple—precious to Him and fiercely protected (vv. 16–17).

We are God's holy temple. That truth changes how we treat one another and how we build the church. Jesus Christ is our unshakable foundation, and God, in His love, refines our work by fire. These are three grace-filled truths that call us to faithfulness, unity, and care in the life we share as the church.

1. Build God's Holy Temple—You ARE His Sacred Construction (vv. 16-17)

"Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you? If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy him. For God's temple is holy, and you are that temple." (1 Cor. 3:16-17)

The HTC family—YOU together (plural)—are God's sacred dwelling where his Spirit lives (Eph. 2:21-22 – "a holy temple... dwelling place for God"; 2 Cor. 6:16 – "we are the temple of the living God"). God calls this gathered community—not buildings but his beloved temple and he fiercely protects it from division, gossip, and corruption. God says: *this family is my holy dwelling—nurture it, speak life to it, and heal together.*

2. Build on Jesus—Only Foundation That Lasts (vv. 10-11)

"According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation... For no one can lay a foundation other than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ." (1 Cor. 3:10-11)

Jesus Christ alone—died, crucified and risen—is the unshakable foundation where God's temple stands secure (Isa. 28:16 – "precious cornerstone... whoever believes will not be put to shame"; Eph. 2:20 – "Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone"). Paul laid this foundation by *grace alone* (no ego, no self-made success), and God equips us too. Jesus remains the one foundation for doctrine, marriage, parenting, and mission. Therefore, *"Let each one take care how he builds."*

3. Build with Gold—Materials That Survive God's Fire (vv. 12-15)

"If anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw—each one's work will become manifest, for the Day will disclose it... the fire will test what sort of work each one has done." (1 Cor. 3:12-13)

God lovingly tests our building by fire, revealing what endures eternally (2 Cor. 5:10 – "receive what is due for what he has done"; Matt. 25:21 – "Well done, good and faithful servant... enter into the joy of your master").

Our Forever Work: Weekly discipling one another, praying through impossible relationships, serving without an Instagram post.

Our Temporary Work: Viral worship reels, packed "experience" events, numbers-driven programs that fade.

God sees our hearts: *work that loves people endures—He rewards our quiet faithfulness.*


Reflection & Discussion


1. Do you truly see the people in this church family as "God's holy temple" (v.16)?
 - a. How has gossip, frustration, or social media criticism treated God's dwelling?
 - b. What one step can you take to cherish and build up this sacred family?
2. What are you functionally building your life on right now—Jesus Christ alone (v.11), or something else like success, relationships, or trends?
 - a. Where do you need to realign a specific decision (parenting, work, dating) to build on Christ, the only foundation that lasts?
3. If Jesus' fire tests your service, parenting, or ministry tomorrow (vv.12-15), what "gold, silver, precious stones" would survive, and what "wood, hay, straw" would burn away?
 - a. What's one "temporary" activity to cut and one "forever" investment to start this week?
4. Knowing God sees you as both his temple AND a builder on his foundation, how does this change your daily priorities?
 - a. Where have you built carelessly, and where can God's grace make you a faithful builder who hears "Well done" on That Day?
