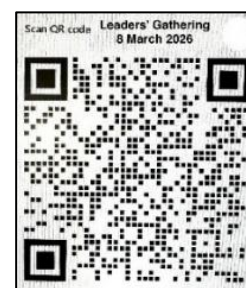
4. VOCAL TRAINING (Weekly) 28 February, 2pm

Join us for **40 Days in the Word**, a powerful six-week journey designed to move us from biblical information to genuine life transformation.

Using Pastor Rick Warren's practical, time-tested methods, you'll learn how to pronounce, picture, and pray Scripture until it becomes part of your everyday life.

Don't settle for simply hearing God's Word—learn to live it and rediscover a deeper passion for God's truth together as a church family.

The study introduces six specific methods of meditation designed to unlock the meaning of Scripture. These methods are practiced together in small groups and then applied individually throughout the week.

Session	Method	Description
One	Pronounce It!	Reading a verse aloud multiple times, emphasizing a different word each time to reveal new layers of meaning.
Two	Picture It!	Visualizing the scene or the truth of the passage to better understand the context and emotional weight.
Three	Probe It!	Asking targeted questions of the text (who, what, where, when, why) to dig deeper into its message.
Four	Paraphrase It!	Rewrite the passage in your own words to ensure a clear personal grasp of the concept.
Five	Personalize It! / Pray It!	Replace biblical pronouns with your own name and turning the text into a personal prayer back to God.
Six	Principles of Interpretation	Learning the foundational rules for correctly understanding and applying biblical truths.

Prayer Pointers

“And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests.

With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints.”

(Ephesians 6:18)

1. Pray for HOLY TRINITY CHURCH - YOUTH MINISTRY (NET)

Sermon Notes

Title: The Veil of Moses: A Glimpse of God's Glory—Illuminated to Shine

Text: Exodus 34:29–35

Preacher: Ps Geraldine Lau

I. Introduction: The Radiant Face of Moses

- Moses descends Mount Sinai with the renewed tablets.
- He is unaware that his face shines because he has been speaking with God.
- The people fear the radiance, so Moses veils his face except when speaking with God or delivering God's message.

II. The Thrust of This Scene

1. **Relationship** — God's presence with Moses
2. **Reflection** — God's glory reflected in Moses
3. **Representative** — Moses as mediator of God's renewed covenant

Three Key Themes

1. **Relationship:** We Reflect What We're Near
2. **Reflection:** His Presence Shapes Our Presence
3. **Representative:** We Represent God Everywhere We Go

A Warning: We Become What We Worship

- Psalm 115:8 — “Those who make them become like them.”

III. From Moses to Christ: The Glory Story Continues (2 Cor 3:7-18)

1. Exodus 34 is a **foreshadowing** of Christ.
2. Moses had **fading glory**; Christ brings **surpassing glory**.
3. Through Jesus, we move from *hidden glory* → *beheld glory* → *reflected glory*.

The Gospel Lens: Unveiled Faces

1. In Christ, we behold God's glory with unveiled faces.
2. We reflect His ever-increasing glory to the world.
3. Our worth is not in what we do, but in who Christ is in us.

Title: The Veil of Moses: A Glimpse of God's Glory—Illuminated to Shine

Text: Exodus 34:29–35

Preacher: Ps Geraldine Lau

Conclusion: Yet Not I, But Through Christ in Me

1. Like Moses, we are called to shine—
2. But our radiance is not our own.
3. It is Christ living in us, working through us, and walking with us.

Key Truth to Take Home

It's not who I am, but WHO HE IS in me that enables me to illuminate His glory.

VI. Application: How to Live Out This Glory Daily

1. Surrender each day to Christ — “Jesus, live through me today.”
2. Invite Christ into your thoughts before acting — “Not by my strength, but Yours.”
3. Reflect Christ in interactions — Seek patience, kindness, wisdom.
4. Celebrate His strength, not your performance.
5. Stay rooted in His presence daily — Scripture, worship, prayers.
6. Let His strength carry you in weakness.
7. Let Christ guide your purpose — “Lord, what do You want to do through me today?”

Closing Prayer

Lord Jesus,
thank You for calling me to behold Your glory and to reflect it in this world.
Live in me, speak through me, and shine Your light wherever I go.
Make my weakness a place for Your strength to rest.
Shape my thoughts, guide my steps, and fill my life with Your presence.
May everything I do today reveal not myself, but You in me.
Amen.
