Prayer Pointers

“Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.” (Philippians 4:6)

1. Pray for HOLY TRINITY CHURCH - CELL GROUPS and SENIOR FELLOWSHIP

a) For Cell Group Leaders, Members, and the Senior Fellowship

Pray for our cell group leaders (Gideon, Owen, Jaden, Audrey, Gabriel, Jolene & Leng Lee, Caleb & Rachel, Edwin, Eunice, Adeline, Ps James) to be refreshed and guided by the Holy Spirit as they shepherd their groups with wisdom, humility, and love. Lift up cell members that they may grow deeper in God’s Word, in genuine fellowship, and in outreach to others. Remember our senior fellowship — thanking God for their faithfulness and legacy of prayer. Pray that they continue to find joy, strength, and purpose in their walk with the Lord, and that their lives would inspire the next generation to persevere in faith.

b) For Growth, Unity, and Impact in the Church Community

Pray that every small group and fellowship within the church would be a living witness of Christ’s love — places of encouragement, healing, and empowerment. Ask God to knit hearts together across generations, building unity and mutual care. Pray for open doors to reach their communities, and for the Spirit to bring renewal, spiritual growth, and lasting fruit through every gathering and relationship.

2. Pray for THE WORLD

a) For the Nations and the Suffering

Pray for God’s mercy, peace, and justice to cover the nations of the world. Ask the Lord to bring an end to conflicts and suffering — particularly the ongoing war between Ukraine and Russia, the devastation caused by flooding in Southeast Brazil, and the unrest and hardship in Mexico. Pray that God’s comfort will reach the grieving, His provision sustain the displaced, and His wisdom guide leaders and decision-makers toward righteousness and compassion.

b) For Singapore — Its Leaders, Citizens, and the Needy

Pray for our nation and its leaders, that God will grant them wisdom, integrity, and compassion as they govern. Ask the Lord to bless our citizens with unity, kindness, and a shared desire to build a just and caring society. Remember the needy, elderly, and marginalized—that they may experience provision, comfort, and community through both national care and the love of the Church. Pray for Singapore’s continued peace, stability, and moral strength, that the nation may flourish under God’s guidance and grace.

c) For the Global Church and God’s Mission

Pray for the global body of Christ to stand firm in faith and shine brightly in a world of brokenness and fear. Ask the Lord to strengthen pastors, missionaries, and believers everywhere — especially those ministering in challenging contexts like Mexico, Brazil, Ukraine, and Russia. Pray that the Church will remain steadfast in love, boldly proclaim the gospel, and work together in unity to bring healing, hope, and transformation to the nations.
