Prayer Pointers

Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.
(Hebrews 4:16)

1. HOLY TRINITY CHURCH

a. Holy Week Services

- Pray for the upcoming Holy Week services — including the Parish Combined Good Friday Service, the Memorial Service, and the Resurrection Sunday Service. Ask that all who attend will come with prepared and humble hearts, ready to encounter God in a fresh and personal way.
- Pray that as we remember Christ's suffering, death, and glorious resurrection, we will deeply reflect on His work of salvation for us. May the Holy Spirit move powerfully through every reading, song, prayer, and message, drawing many into repentance, renewed faith, and joyful celebration of our risen Lord.

b. Nomination of Committee Members (Chinese and English Congregations)

- Pray that the counsel of the Holy Spirit will guide us as a church to discern and nominate the appropriate people (People's warden, Synod Representatives, and Committee members of the respective congregations) who will serve God and His people wholeheartedly.
- Pray that those who are called will respond with humility, willingness, and faithfulness.
- Ask that our church will remain God-centered, united, and prayerful throughout the entire process of nomination and election.

2. THE WORLD - The Conflict in the Middle East

a. Peace in areas of conflict and Healing for those affected

- Pray for God's mercy to restrain violence, protect the innocent, and move leaders, especially in conflict areas like Iran and Israel, to pursue lasting peace guided by the Spirit of Christ.
- Pray for God's healing, comfort, and strength over all affected by disasters, attacks, and emergencies, and for first responders and communities to be upheld by His unfailing love.

b. Singapore and its neighbours - The haze situation

- Pray for God's protection and mercy over those impacted by poor air quality and environmental harm, asking Him to cleanse the land, give wisdom to leaders, and safeguard vulnerable lives.
